As Preacher, he was a diligent student, His sermons were prepared with great care and were delivered in a most attractive and impressive manner, and with the unction of one who spoke from deep conviction and the heart of his preaching during all these years, was the old, old story of the Changeless Christ--the glorious Gospel of the Blessed God.

That as Pastor, he always responed cheerfully and gladly to the pathetic cry of the sick and was always ready to help those in deep need of whatever kind, The sick and the suffering in the hospital were cheered andcomforted by his daily visits and encourgging words, spoken from a sympethetic heart. His prayers offered in the presence of the dead of loved one, brought comfort to those whose hearts were crushed with deep sorrow.

As a Presbyter, he was rarely absent from the meetings of the Church courts. His counsel and advice were often sought. As evidence of the high esteem in which he was held, he was elected as Superintendent of Home Missions in Winston Salem Presbytery, the most important office that the Presbytery could bestow. He discharged the duties of that office in a very highly satisfactory manner. The workers in the field called Him Blessed.

As a Citizen, he was deeply interested in all that made for the welfare of the Town and Community and was always ready to lend a helping handin every worthy undertaking. Of him, it could be said that he was a model citizen.

As a Friend, he was loyal and true, a wise councleor and a faithful friend always ready to extend the helping hand and the sympatheticx heart.

THEREFORE, the Congregation reconizing his being called to this new Field of Labor by the Great Head of the Church and feeling also that this NAME new Field offers a greater opportunity for Service for the Advancement of the Kingdom, with great sadness, joins with him in requesting the Winston Salem Presbytery to dissolve the pastoral relations between Rev. J.W.McFall and the First Presbyterian Church of Mount Airy, North Caroline."

As Preacher, he was a diligent student. His

sermons were prepared with great care and were delivered in an attractive and impressive manner, and with the unction of one who spoke from deep conviction and the heart of his preaching was the old, old story of the Changeless Christ-the glorious Gospel of the Blessed God.

That as Pastor, he always responded cheerfully and gladly to the pathetic cry of the sick and was always ready to help those in deep need of whatever kind. The sick and the suffering in the hospital were cheered and comforted by his daily visits and encouraging words, spoken from a sympathetic heart. His prayers, offered in the presence of the dead of loved one, brought comfort to those whose hearts were chrushed with deep sorrow.

As evidence of the high esteem in which he was held, he was elected as Chairman of the Stuardship Committee of Winston-Salem Presbytery, a most important committe. As a Citizen, he was deeply interested

in all that made for the welfare of the Town and Community and was always ready to lend a helping hand in every worthy undertaking. Of him, it could be said that he was a model citizen.

As a Friend, he was loyal and true, a wise counselor and a faithful friend always ready to extend a helping hand and sympathetic heart.

THEREFORE, the congregation recognizing his call of the Government as Chaplain for the Allies, and feeling that his new field offers a greater opportunity for service for the Advancement of the Kingdom, with great sadness, joins with him in requesting the Winston-Salem Presbytery to dissolve the pastoral relations between J. B. Ficklen III and the First Presbyterian Church of Mount Airy, North Carolina.
