The Beginning

Mahala Jessup Simmons and her daughter, loda Simmons, travel by horse and buggy to the Friends Mission in the Blue Ridge Mountain of Virginia. Mahala invited a Presbyterian minister to the foothills of Slate Mountain to preach.

The people built a brush harbor for a place to hold the services, wooden benches were also made to sit on, the attendance was great. After a short time under the brush harbor, the congregation moved across the road to the Joe Goins house (now the home of Victor and Viola Burkhart).

John B. Simmons organized a Sunday School being Superintendent and song leader. The crowd was so great that more room was needed for Sunday School and preaching services. These meetings were held on Sunday afternoons. This was the first time for most of the people to attend a Sunday School or go to public school. Joe Goins tore out the west end of his house to meet the needs of the growing number of people who attended. The first Revival was held by Rev. Joe Simmons. Many people accepted Christ as their Savior and were baptized in Archer Creek.

On September 20, 1914, the congregation assembled and formed a Presbytery for the purpose of organizing a Baptist Church. The Presbytery was composed of the following Ministers:


JOINED PILOT MOUNTAIN ASSOCIATION August 3, 1915



JOSEPH W. SIMMONS 1914-1917

He was born June 10, 1871 in Surry County, North Carolina. He married Mary Alice Belton December 5, 1900. He was a stone cutter, specializing in corner stones, working for Mount Airy Granite. In more than 30 years of ministry, he pastored 28 churches. He died November 29, 1939.



JIM O. BELTON 1917-1928

He was born May 10, 1879 in Surry County, North Carolina, the son of William Henry and Mary Ann Griffith Belton. On December 24, 1902, he married Mary Jane Shaw. He was a stone cutter and was the first secretary of the union of stone cutters. He pastored churches in North Carolina, South Carolina, and Virginia for over 50 years. He died February 26, 1956.

WALTER LEONARD JOHNSON 1929-1930




GEORGE A. TUCKER 1930-1942

George Tucker was born April 14, 1890. On March 10, 1908, he married Regina Mae Jackson. He was ordained as minister in 1909 at Holly Springs Baptist Church. During his 50 years of ministry, he pastored Piney Grove, Highland Park, Little Mountain, Copeland, Hill Grove, Mount Carmel, Salem, Rocky Knoll, Friendship, Olive Grove, and Red Branch at Carthage, North Carolina. He helped in organizing 31 churches and rebuilding several. He died February 23, 1973.




HUBERT HAWKS 1943-1944

He was born July 18, 1903, the son of A.A. Hawks and Laura Hawks. He married Pencie M. Hawks on June 15, 1926. Hubert was ordained in 1940 at Calvary Baptist Church in Mount Airy, North Carolina. In his 25 years of ministry, he pastored Paul's Creek, Fancy Gap, New Life, Indian Grove, Stone Mountain, Rome, Pilot View, Crooked Oak, Pleason Grove and Hurricane in Wise, Virginia. He died November, 1965.



WILLIAM T. CRISSMAN 1944-1945

He was born January 10, 1874. He married Lille Wood of Siloam, North Carolina. In his 25 years of ministry, he served Baptist Churches in Surry, Yadkin, and Forsyth Counties. He died July 5, 1945 from injuries received when he was kicked by a horse shortly before noon the day before. He was pastor of Friendship, New Bethel, and Slate Mountain at the time of his death.



TOM COOK 1945-1947

Tom Cook was born May 16, 1908 in Surry County, North Carolina. He married Lena Mills on August 24, 1929. He was ordained as a minister in 1947 by Slate Mountain Baptist Church. He helped organize Sunday School at Albion Baptist Church July 9, 1939. While pastoring Slate Mountain, he helped build the new church in 1946. During his time as pastor from 1976-1983, he led in helping build new Sunday School rooms and enlarging the sanctuary. Tom also pastored Woodville, Sulphur Springs, Salem, Stoney Ridge, Ried Island Springs, Oak Ridge, and Green Mountain. He was supply pastor in other churches.




JOSEPH WESLEY COOK 1948-1949

Joseph was born December 15, 1914 in Surry County, North Carolina, the son of Dowell F. and Elizabeth Simmons Cook. He married Elsie Mae Taylor on March 26, 1932. Olive Grove Baptist Church ordained Rev. Cook on November 7, 1948. He attended Fruitland Bible Institute and Southeastern Theological Seminary, Wake Forest, North Carolina. He pastored Piney Grove, Little Mountain, Brown Mountain, Stoney Ridge, and Woodville. Rev. Joseph Wesley Cook died June 15, 1973.


CHARLES LINWOOD HARRIS 1952


GEORGE A. TUCKER August 2, 1953-February, 1959


JOHN D. BOWMAN April 1, 1959-April, 1961


ROY E. CANFIELD October 17, 1965-August 28, 1966



Slate Mountain Baptist Church has been and continues to be a vital force in the lives of its members. It is comprised of a loving and loyal congregation who take pride in the maintenance and improvement of their church. The members are also dedicated to the spreading of the gospel and to the support of the church, the pastor, and each other.

We maintain an average Sunday school attendance of approximately 55 to 60, with more than 100 attending the Sunday morning worship service.

Many changes and improvements have been made throughout the years. In 2003 the sanctuary was remodeled with new oak wainscoting, oak pews, communion table, carpet, and lighting. In 2006 improvements were made to the library and a new piano was purchased. The basement fellowship area was remodeled in 2008 with cabinets, countertops, and floor replaced. A new refrigerator, stove, and microwave oven were also purchased at this time. In 2009 a back porch with a ramp was built for easier access into the building. In 2010 we purchased tables and chairs which are now being used in our new Fellowship Building that was completed in 2013.

The WMU continues to be very active and sponsors worthwhile projects such as participation in the Samaritan's Purse Shoebox Ministry, Red Cross Blood Drives, and assisting families by providing meals during times of sickness and death. The Baptist Brotherhood holds monthly meetings and does minor repairs and maintenance projects around the church. Our youth group is also very active as participants in church plays, a youth choir, and an annual Youth Sunday. On Wednesday nights the children and youth meet in the Fellowship Building for Bible stories/study and activities.

Slate Mountain Baptist Church continues to carry out a ministry that lifts up Jesus Christ through worship services and programs that meet the spiritual needs of the community. The church seeks to spread the gospel throughout the world through mission support and to faithfully serve our Lord and Savior until He returns.
