**Ted McGraw Smith**

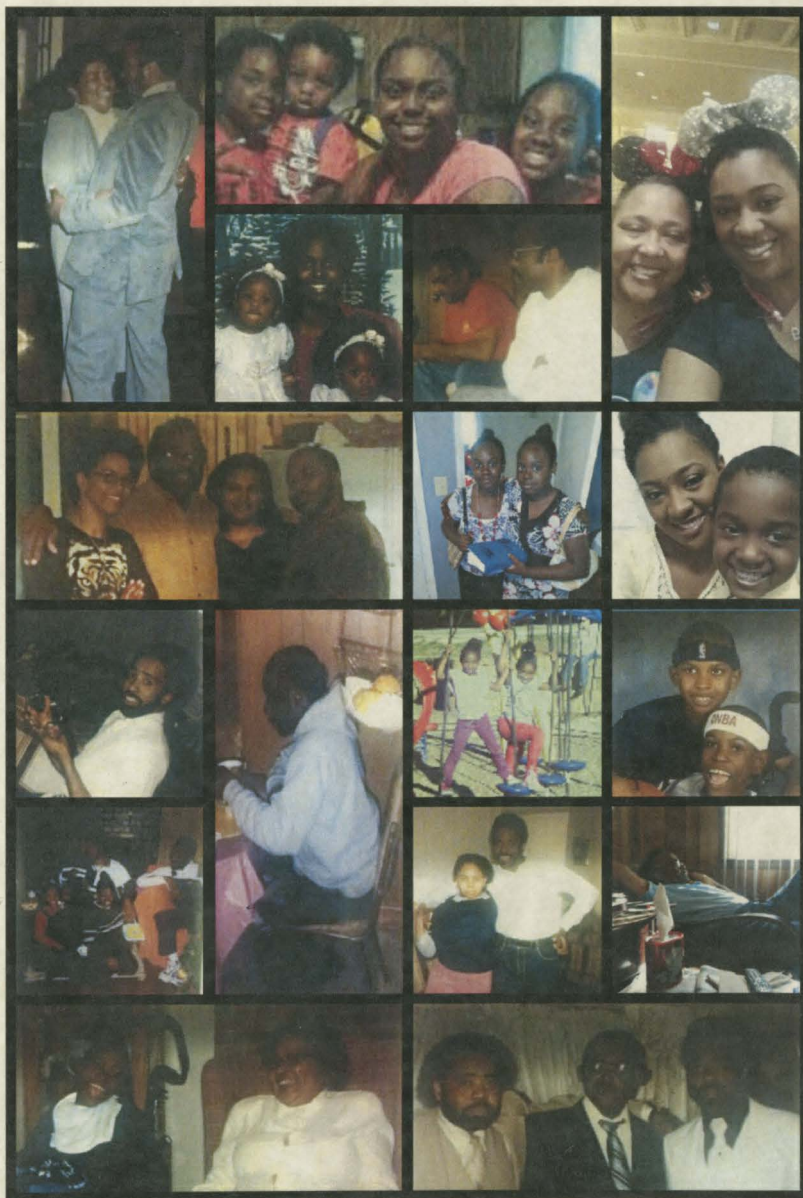
