1969-1970 WATCHWORD

"Our love should not be just words and talk; it must be true love, which shows itself in action." (1 John 3:18 TEV)

John knows well the temptation to substitute talk about love for deeds of love and also the temptation to substitute deeds that appear to be loving, for love in truth. Love as it is defined in this passage is a claim upon the church as a whole as well as upon believers as individuals. To be true love, it is clear that even where acts are performed, they must be genuine.

Christians are admonished to show love, not by hymns and professions alone, but by daily life. The application of this rule is surprising because of its down-to-earth practicality. Through W.M.U.'s plan of mission action, Christians can show their love as they minister and witness to persons of special need. Mission action is a one-to-one ministry--like the ministry of Jesus.

When the occasion arises, Christians ought to show their love, for in so doing, they show themselves to be God's children.
