My search leads me to 1850 census report for Jackson County Tenn. (no. (j)1110-1111-630) with these results.

As you can see the 1840 census for North Carolina should show four children ref: Surry County page 60: (by Helen Parsonage)

William Lambert

1 male under 5

1 male 30-40

1 female under 5

2 females 5-10

1 female 20-30

These ages and genders check closely and I suspect this is the person (my great-great-grandfather)for whom I search.

Mrs. Parsonage also provided marriage bond for two William Lamberts.  
ref: William Lambert and Polly Lambert March-29-1828 # 000145815 Surry County and  
William Lambert and Katherine Lewis April-29-1831 Surry County # 000145813.  
(Would love to have copies)

I expect my search to lead to William and Katherine but possissibaly exists that this could be the same William, but Mrs. Parsonage states that 1830 census shows no mention of a William being head of household in Surry County. (Moved to other county ect.)?

Any help or direction will be forever appearicated, please inform me of any Lamberts in Surry ect. who might be searching same genealogy.

Need to know what happened to Williams first Spouse ect.

Need copies of marriage bonds. (Need addresses State Archives in Raleigh)?

Need copies of birth certs. and death certs. (Surry County)?

Well, I am new to genealogy research so you know more about what I need and where to obtain it than I do. Should this "William" prove to be the right one I plan a trip to Surry county this spring or earlier.

Thank you for your letter postmarked January 6, 1997 regarding William Lambert. We are sending you copies of the marriage bonds you requested on William Lambert. We are sorry that they are not good copies. The address for the State Archives is: Department of Cultural Resources, Archives and Records Section, 109 E. Jones Street, Raleigh, NC 27601-2807.

We are sending you copies of surname cards we had on file of researchers of the Lambert family.

We found a William Lambert listed in Wilkes County and Wake County in the 1830 NC Census. Wilkes County formed from Surry in 1779. In the 1820 NC Census listed were a William Lambert in New Hanover Co. and Guilford Co. You might want to write the Wilkes Genealogical Society, Inc., P. O. Box 1629, North Wilkesboro, NC 28659.

Surry County did not keep birth and death certificates until 1914. There are some Delayed Birth Certificates on file before 1900.

We are sending you a copy of a deed Joel Jackson from William Lambert (1841, Book 1, page 458-459).

We invite you to send a query for our quarterly journal and surname cards for our file.
