We received information 8:50 A. M., November 5th, from Track Supervisor A. E. Chambers, Winston-Salem Division, that automobile had hit underpass at Bragg Street, Greensboro, N. C.

Immediate investigation developed that piling of this underpass was struck by a 1939 model Dodge sedan, N. C. License X-1567, owned and driven by Mr. Owen Tyler Roach, Route 4, Greensboro, N. C., at approximately 2:00 A. M., November 5th, 1954.

Cost of repairs to piling amounted to \$35.50.

Bill was presented to Mr. Roach, who advises that he is unable to pay cost of damages at this time, and he has promised to take care of this matter as soon as possible.


Cost of repairs to this structure amounted to \$35.50.
