Dear Mr. Brinson,

Sorry to have held you back from your research. We are in dire need of more people who are willing to help with the projects.

I have been able to find absolutely nothing in the Military Records that will give us an accurate account of what James Brinson was paid to do or for what. The gentleman in charge of the search room desk agrees with me that that particular voucher does not look like those issued for military service and that more than likely he provided beef, hogs, liquor or some such. Especially the larger voucher.

Rechecked the Treasurer & Comptrollers books and only tonight wondered if the entry for J. Brinn, Vol. VI, Pg. 80, Folio 3 and James Brins, IX, Pg. 109, Folia 2 might not be your James Brinson. I shall look at these entries when next I am in the Archives. That will be about next tuesday. There just isn't anything else that looks like an entry for him.-----CANCEL that idea. I checked the 1790 census and there are men by ~~that~~ names in other parts of the state, and , of course, your James Brinson is in Craven Co.

At the Secretary of States Land Grant office in the Administration Bldg. I do not find in the military warrents/anything for James Brinson. There is one grant for James Briston; Assn. #268 in Sumner Co. for 228 acres. This grant was entered in 1787 and Issued in Dec. of 1790. It was Assigned by Goldman Harris to James Briston ; Assn.

A second military warrent was issued to James Brister of Sumner Co. #736 for 228 acres entered in 1783 and granted in 1793.

I do not believe that either of these is your James Brinson.

The Delamar Transcripts show nothing on James Brinson. These are petitions concerning Revolutionary War Service in the Legislative Papers from 1778 to 1833..

There is nothing in the Secr'y of State Revolutionary collection.

Again, there is nothing on James Brinson in the Colonial Records Index by Weeks.

I am very sorry that there is nothing available showing James Brinsons service record. Both Mr. Simpson & I have spent a great deal of time trying to prove this for you. (As I have noted before, the pay voucher is accepted proof by DAR and that sort of organization.

You say that you have proven your Brinsons back to something like 1730. Have you done the Estate Records for the counties. Be sure to check into those as there is much to be found there on the children and property.

Dear Mr. Brinson,

I have worked on the Brinson research a few hours and now I need to know if you had wanted me to pick up on the line in La. and bring it back to N.C. or if you were only interested in the Brinsons who served in the Revolutionary War.

In the La. census records for 1840 and 1830 are listed Josiah and a Phillip in Claiborne Co. In 1820 is a James in Quachita Co. I note on a map that they are both in the northern most part of the state and only one county apart. Strongly suggest that someone get into the Quachita Co. probate (wills) and deed records and see if James might not be the father of your Josiah. (Of course, it could be the Phillip that is showing with Josiah. With a burnt county, it might stop right here.)

The copies of the pay vouchers are proof of service by any of the organizations requiring such. The little round blanks on them are where they were punched when turned in for the money. These are the actual slips that the men carried about in their pockets.

Besides the men listed on the vouchers, we also have an Isaac and an A. Brinson listed in the Treasurer and Comptrollers books.

In N.C. 1785-7 census are listed: Adam, Benjamin, Ganse, George, Isaac, Isaac Jr., John Esq. and Mather Brinson in Onslow. Benj. was in Duplin Co.

1790 census shows in Halifax Co a Asehel B., page 62
Benjamin in Craven, page 133. Also a Cason and Daniel and two Jameses. Joseph and Mathew also Craven.
Onslow has Gause & George, John and Matthew.
New Hanover has a Henry Brinson.

1800 shows six Brinson families in Craven Co., two in Onslow Co., one in Duplin, one in Camden and one in Brunswick Co. No James or Josiah - or Phillip.

1810 lists only two families in Onslow Co. Elizth and Lott.

May I go ahead and try and tie the James Brinson here with the one listed on the La. census and the Josiah or would you rather I stop??


Herewith enclosed is a check in the amount of \$5.00, as per your last letter. Any other charges will be promptly paid for services rendered.

You may need to contact the proper record holder at New Bern. I think I have quite a few relatives there and I am sure that some of them would help you; however, you probably don't need them.

In closing I will again say that I would like to have a copy of any records that are available that James -- Brinson served in the war. Of course, I mean the one that was the father of James J. Brinson of North Louisiana.



Dear Ms. Camin:

The purpose in writing you is to determine if you and I can make satisfactory arrangements whereby you and I could work together in you getting satisfactorily paid for a service you may be capable of rendering and I could receive information I want concerning one or more Brinsons who were in the Revolutionary War. I have had some experience in working with a geneologist and I think an understanding is necessary as to the type of information that is desired and how the charges are to be calculated in billings.

I am past seventy years now; however, I have had no knowledge of my family on my father's side until about two years ago. I started trying to learn just how to research family records. In doing so, I enlisted help from a geneologist here in Texas and together, and more especially from distant relatives, I learned how to and did locate a more or less positive record of my family back to about 1730.

It appears that immediately after the Revolutionary War, James Brinson was granted 5,000 acres of land located in what is now Wilson County, Tennessee. It is thought that this grant was due to his service in the Revolution. This is where my search has stopped.


Now, about the first of this year I heard that a Brinson, who was reared in New Bern, North Carolina, was writing a family record book. My daughter called him at his home in Edgewater, Maryland and he said that although his book was over-subscribed, he would send her a few when they were available from the printer. I placed a call to him several days later and was advised by his wife that he had died a few days before my call to him. His wife sent me four books later on. My call to him was more or less just to converse with him.

The book has over 900 pages and one is now in the National Archives. Needless to say, we are real sorry to hear of his death and certainly appreciate the book. The book starts with the first Brinson that landed in Virginia and follows the Cason Brinson line from there to the present with numerous branches. I have picked up my father's line and it also goes back and connects James J. Brinson. He was my great-great-great-grandfather and was born February 5, 1730. I need to have all the proof available of any Brinson that served in the Revolutionary War, if any. I need the information for obvious reasons; however, I want to make it available for my 13 year old granddaughter who has won a complimentary first place honor in writing an essay on the DAR and a nice medal. This would be a nice surprise for her as she is interested in things of this nature.

Please advise me if you would care to do the work and how the charges will be based.
