To the Honorable Court of County Commissioners

Whereas I, James Inscore of the county and state aforesaid having had the misfortune to loose my arm in the past difficulty of the country and having a family and being quite unable to support myself and family by my labor I therefore humbly pray your court (if there be no law to forbid) to grant me privilege to **retail spiritous liquor** to enable me the better to support me and family.
