This indenture made 26 day may in the year of  
our lord one thousand eighteen hundred eighty three  
between B Smith & J S Smith as executors of  
Catlett Smith Decease of the one part and the said  
Hilary Barker of the other part both of the County  
of Surry & State of North Carolina witness  
that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred  
& thirty one dollars in hand paid do at Bargain sell  
and deliver unto the said Hilary Barker a certain  
parcel or tract of land lying bearing on the waters of  
little fishers River ad joining the lands Daniel Barker  
and others bearing in the County of Surry & state of North  
Carolina beginning at a white oak on the north of the River  
running west twenty four chain to chestnut thence  
North fifteen chain to chestnut <sup>west</sup> fifteen chain  
to a poplar thence South forty six chains to chestnut  
thence east thirty nine chains to chestnut thence  
North thirty one chains to the Beginning containing  
one hundred & forty three acres to have and to hold  
& ever appertaining there unto belonging in any wise  
to his heirs & sign doath here by Bargain sell &  
do deliver unto the said Hilary Barker the land premise  
the said B Smith & John Smith has full right to sell &  
deliver unto the said Hilary Barker the said B Smith  
& John Smith agrees to warrant & forever defend the rights  
and titles of the same either in law or equity against the  
claims of any where unto we have set our hands on seal
