Have just been on a trip with my husband, went to the Dept. of Archives and History in Montgomery and visited Milo Howard and called Jackson Stell and caught up on all the Ala workings. I found a published account of a Wasson descendant, she said the John Wasson married a Miss Church and had John Wasson who married Viney England and they had Edward England Wasson.

Now, the only John with a male in his house old enough to be our John who was born in 1775 is John of ROWAN CO. N. C. He has three while males over 16. . John of Lincoln only had 4 males under 16. May be a mistake but I have thought that ~~Archibald Wasson who was in Rown 1861~~ may have been the father of our John. There is an inventory of Archibalds estate. Am enclosing the record, could you see if his children are mentioned? Do we have a John Wasson who married a Miss CHURCH anywhere, before 1775? He may have married in Virginia.

Well, I cannot find the Xerox copy of Archibalds Misplaced Rowan Co. Inventories and Sales 1785-1787 made 1785 p 43 AND IT IS LISTED ON P 43 NCGSJournal Vol v No.1 Feb 1979

I see that the Court Minutes have been published up to 1792, wonder if Mrs. Haun is doing the 1792-on that you are reading? Might save time to check with her. Remember our Wm Hornsby was born 1797 probably in Wake, and it is much aafter that that we would need a PA or something, Jo Linns' quote: " ZIt is evident that William and Ebenezer Hornsby went from Granville to Wake Co between 1790 and 1800. The minutes of C of P and Q Sessions for Wake Co would show deeds being proved when they bought and sold property there." Wm and Ebenezer show up in Roane Co. Tn by 1830 census, actually are there in 1820's.
