Thank you for your letter dated July 26, 1999 regarding the Dunnagan family. We checked our early church records available but did not find any mention of John Dunnagan, preacher. Church records in this area are very hard to come by unless they are Quaker or Moravian. The kept very good records.

We suggest you send us a query to print in our journal and place surname cards in our file. Information is enclosed.

We did find two Dunnagans buried in the oldest church cemetery in Mount Airy so we thought he may have been a preacher there. Our church history of that church did not mention him. Buried at the Old Methodist Church Cemetery are A. J. Dunnagan who died 8 Feb 1890 at age 76 and his wife M. J. Dunnagan who died 7 Dec 1890 at age 88. (This may be Anderson Dunnagan.) This information came from one of the cemetery books of Surry County and we cannot say this information is absolutely correct. The actual headstones would need to be checked. North Carolina did not keep birth and death records until 1913. He could be in an unmarked grave somewhere or the old cemetery could have been destroyed as such a cemetery was located in downtown Mount Airy many years ago.

Found on the Hughes Surry County Historical Map was Dunagan Creek, John Dunnagan (1784) and (1770), John Dunnegan Jr. (1793), Joseph Dunnegan (1788), and Thomas Dunnegan (1770). They were on the Toms Creek area of Surry County. Toms Creek rises in east Surry County and flows southwest into Ararat River. This is a very nice large map showing the early settlers of Surry County. You might want to order this map if you don't have a copy. Order the map and index for \$5 from the Surry County Register of Deeds, P. O. Box 303, Dobson, NC 27017.

No wills were found on early Dunnagans. Estate records were listed for Anderson Dunnigan (1891), Henry Dunnigan (1899), Littleton Dunnigan (1866), Reuben Dunnigan (1867), Thomas F. Dunigan (1890), and Tyre Dunnigan (1864). You could order these records from the Department of Cultural Resources, Archives and Records Section, 109 E. Jones Street, Raleigh, NC 27601-2807.

We are sending you the copy of the marriage bond found at the Surry County courthouse on Absolom Dunnagan. As you know, there is no date or name of the bride on the bond.

In the book "Joseph Winston, His Entry Book, Surry County, NC Land Entries 1778-1781," Dunagans listed in the index are John, Joseph, Josephs Old Mill, Thomas, Thomas Junr. and Thomas Senr. (See enclosed listing regarding this book.)

You can order a copy of our journal dated April 1989 for \$5. The article on page 16 is called "The Dunnegan Family" that was submitted by Kathryn Creed who is now deceased.

Surry County has a DAR chapter. Would you want to see if they have members that might be connected to your line of Dunnagans. It might be worth a try to write them. Write Jonathan Hunt Chapter of the NSDAR, Attn: Alice Brumfield, 321 Virginia Drive, Yadkinville, NC 27055.

We wish that we could help you more on this family. We know there has been research done on this family but we do not have the information in our files. We would love to have a copy of your family group sheets and pedigree charts as well as any other information you can provide on this family as they were one of our early families. Our church history of that church is at the Old Methodist Church Cemetery are A. J. Dunnegan who If you feel we can help further, please write us again. Good luck with your research and your membership with the DAR.

Could you please let me know the church, or where I could find the church records, for John Dunnagan, "preacher", of Surry Co. N.C. His son, Abraham (my ancestor) born 1778, Surry Co., had sons, John (1804, Surry Co.) Samuel (1806 Wythe, VA) and Thompson (1808 VA). I descend from Samuel who came to MO. I need a document (copy of) that "ties" Abraham and his father, John Dunnagan, together. Also, what cemetery would John be buried in? (if known).

I have copies of vouchers where he, John, gave aid to the cause of the American Revolution. But do not have John's birth and death date, or the mother of the children, or the children's names. I thought a church record, or estate record might give that information. Family history told that "John moved his family to the Mt. Airy region".

I do not know the cost of the documents, or research, for it, but am enclosing a SASE envelope for your convenience in giving me an answer to that, or where I can find it.

Also, Absalom's ^(Dunnagan) marriage is not recorded on the NC records, it appears, in library research for marriages and Bonds of N.C. The bride's name and date are missing, but Bondsman's name of Martin Armstrong, bond # 000144278 and record # 092 01 066 are on record. Do you know, would her name be on the license record # of above?

Also, if Absalom's son, John ^{Dunnagan} was born 1804 Surry Co, N.C., ^{Absalom} ~~he~~ likely was married around, or right after, 1800. They said his "preacher" father, John Dunnagan, had "married" others in the family (performed the ceremony). If Church records were saved, some of the family information might be in them.

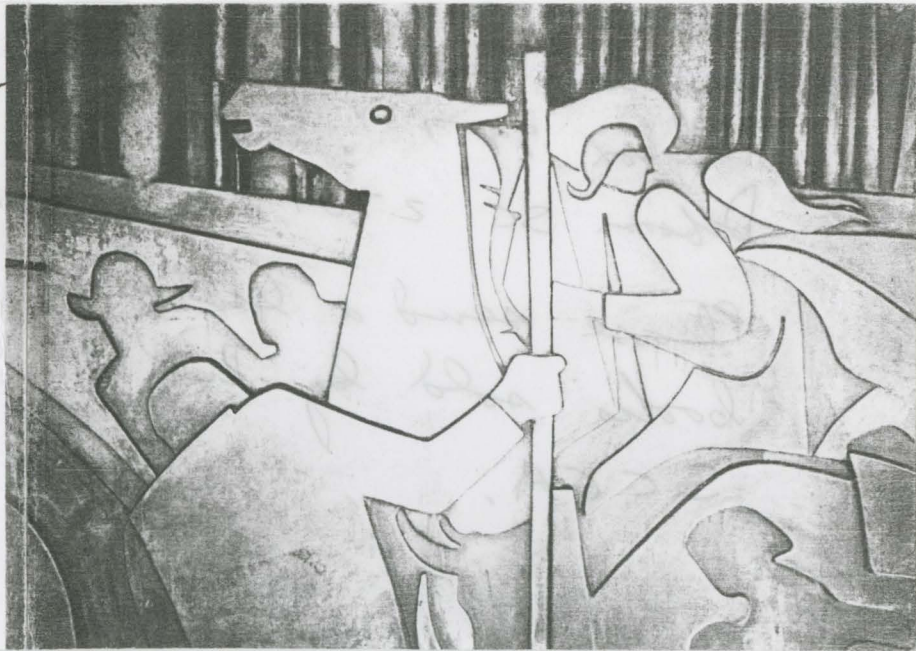

We really don't have the time to list all the Dunagans in all the books on our list at this time. We will do a few. Sorry it has taken so long to answer your notes. As far as the new pictorial book we have done, this book covered the early 1900s to 1940 and we don't recall any Dunagans in it. It does not have an index.

Volume I of our heritage book has sold out and in Volume II we only have a surname index of seven names. There are no major Dunagan family histories in either of the heritage books.

Joseph Winston His Entry Book Surry County, NC Land Entries 1778-1781 listed John, Joseph, Joseps Old Mill, Thomas, Thomas, Junr., and Thomas, Senr.

Surry County, NC Will Abstracts Book 4 (1827-1853) listed Anderson, Elizabeth, James, Sarah and Tyre Dunnegan.

Surry County, NC Will Abstracts Volumes 5 & 6 1853-1901 listed R., A., Allgias, Anderson, Henry, Reubin, Rubin, Tyra, W. H. and Willie Dunnagan.

1830 Census of Surry County, NC listed Joseph, Justice, Lewis, and Tyre Dunigan.

Taxables in Surry County, NC for the Year 1835 listed Lewis, James, and Tyre Dunnigan.

Surry County Soldiers in the Civil War listed Anderson, Diannah, Joel, Reuben, Tyre and Algias Dunnagan.

1850 Census of Surry County, NC listed Elizabeth, James, Lewis, Algins, Anderson and Tyre Dunnagan.

Surry County Tax List for the Year 1862 listed A. C., Anderson, Henry, Reuben, and Tyre Dunagan.

1870 Population Schedule Products of Industry Schedule & Mortality Schedule for Surry County, NC (1870 Census) listed A. C., A., Paty, and Henry Dunnigan.

Of course there were slightly different spellings of this surname in the indexes of these books.

On the Surry County Historical Map of early Surry landowners are Dunagan Creek, John Dunnagan (1784), John Dunnegan (1770), John Dunnegan, Jr. (1793), Joseph Dunnegan (1788) and Thomas Dunnegan (1770). If you don't have this map, you really should order a map and index (cost is \$5) from the Surry County Register of Deeds, P. O. Box 303, Dobson, NC 27017. It is a very nice large map for the money.

We hope this has helped some. We feel sure these same Dunagans are listed in the many tax books, deed books and court record books that are available.

We thank you for the Newsletter that you send to SCGA and for your support. If you must have the lists out of the other books listed, we could probably get them given a little time.

I again apologize for carelessly making my unreasonable request and express my pleasure that you did the checking that you did.


