Lillie Myrtle Hollingsworth Roberson (1894-1977)

Lillie Myrtle Hollingsworth was born on June 3, 1894 to Joe Hollingsworth and Ada Mae Jessup Hollingsworth. The census of 1910 in Westfield, Surry County, NC states that Lillie was age 15. Joseph S. Hollinsworth is age 40 and born in NC. His wife is shown as Alse L., age 34, born in NC. Joseph was a farmer. Also in the household were Lillie's siblings Pearly M, age 10; Aldry I, age 5; Rader M., age 3; and a hired man by the name of Paul Arrington, age 23. All of them were born in NC.

On May 5, 1921 she married George C. Roberson and they made their home at 150 W. Church Street, Mount Airy, NC. (See the copy of the marriage license.)

The census of 1920 states that George C. Roberson is age 23 and son of William G. Roberson (age 47) and Julia Qualls Roberson (age 48). George's siblings listed are Gurney W., age 24; Carrie Roberson, age 16; Mark B., age 15; Ruby, age 11; Gobam W., age 8; and Edna A., age 5.

We contacted Gerald Collins, an old-time resident of Mount Airy, and asked him about George Roberson and if he knew of him. In an email reply from Gerald he stated that he knew George lived on Church Street and operated Snappy Lunch in Mount Airy. Gerald stated that George always had a vegetable garden and was a very friendly man.

We went online and found a nice write-up regarding the Snappy Lunch. Snappy Lunch is well known far and wide. On visits to Mount Airy, we always try to make at least one stop at Snappy's. This write-up states that George opened Snappy Lunch in 1923. Over the years the partnerships were sold to others. As far as we know Charles Dowell is now the sole owner. Many famous folks, Andy Griffith among them, has been served at Snappy's. (See the history of the Snappy Lunch.)

Now back to the research of George Roberson. From the Social Security Death Files we found his death is listed as November 1984. The death certificate was not found in Surry County. Teresa Smith of the Register of Deeds office contacted Moody Funeral Home and was able to obtain a copy of the funeral arrangements made for George, dated November 16, 1984. A copy of the Oakdale Cemetery plots listed for George Roberson shows the plots for Lillie and George as "open." We know from Moody's records that both of them are buried in the Roberson plots.

Lillie passed away on April 23, 1977 and is buried in Oakdale Cemetery in Mount Airy, NC. (See the copy of the Certificate of Death for Lillie.)



I wish to become a regular member of your association for 1991 and am enclosing \$10.00 for dues.

I am researching the parents of Thomas Robison (Robeson) ^①, who said he was born in Surry Co. around 1792. He can last be located in Burke Co. NC, where he married Anna (Robson) Hyatt in 1817. She had obtained a divorce from Seth Hyatt in 1813.

I have done some research in Surry County and located a Thomas Robeson ^② in the 1800 Federal Census that inherited 300 acres on Mill Creek from his father William Robeson, Senior ^③ on 9 Aug. 1809. It was land that Thomas ^② formerly lived on. He was born during the period 1755 - 1774, probably around 1763, and is believed to have married Nancy around 1783. Thomas ^② and Nancy witnessed the sale of land on Wooten's

Branck in 1791. In 1801 Thomas⁽²⁾ bought 30 acres on Dills Creek adjoining his father. In 1805 he sold 100 acres to John Roberson⁽⁴⁾ Senior on Wootens Branch of Tinkers River. Thomas⁽²⁾ probably moved to Casey County, KY., between 1805-1809 because he sold his 200 acres on Dills Creek to William Roberson junior⁽⁵⁾ in 1813. He was in Kentucky and the deed was recorded in Perry.

Further, the eldest son of Thomas⁽¹⁾ was John A. Robinson⁽²⁾, born in Burke Co., NC, in 1818. The more obvious connection would be through the John Robisons in 1800 Surry County. However, they are not mentioned in the will of Wm. Robison Sr.⁽³⁾. John⁽⁴⁾ may have been a brother of William⁽³⁾ since they paid poll taxes together in 1772-74 in Surry. In 1778 William⁽³⁾ was granted 400 acres on Hill's Creek and John⁽⁴⁾ was granted 200 acres on Beaver Island Creek (now Stokes Co.).

Would like the name of a local person who could do in-depth research on the Robisons of 1800 Surry County.
