A brief history of the Dudley Family contributed by Naoma Dudley Sloan "Robert told his children that he was born in Caroline County, VA. We, therefore, know that his Father, Charles, was in Virginia before migrating to Surry County, NC and raised his family there. His first land grant Warrent of survey is dated Nov. 21, 1777 in Surry Co. Three other grants at various dates, were issued totaling about 1000 acres. The Dudley families lived in Surry Co., NC untill about 1828. At that time the great westward movement had begun and free government land was available for the asking. Robert's three sons left Surry County, NC with the intent of moving westward into new territory. Most of the daughters remained in Surry or migrated later as they married.

Robert and Clarissa had 10 living children: James Ransom, Mary, William Partham, Elizabeth, Nancy, Charles, Clarissa, Judith, Frances, and Celia.

James Ransom Dudley and William Parham Dudley came into Montgomery County, VA circa 1828-1829 and settled there due to the hardship of traveling with young children. The youngest brother Charles and wife Ann continued into IN territory and are there recorded in the Monroe Co. census of 1850 with 8 children. Pulaski became a VA County in 1838 and was a part of the original Montgomery County. These two counties contain many descendants of James R. and William P. Dudley today. A part of William Parham Dudley's family moved to Tazewell County circa 1858 and descendants are to be found there and in Bluefield, WV."

Dear Judy,

I finally found time to enter into my database, the Dudley information sent to me in July by Jo Adams. My Dudley database also includes many additions since I last sent you a copy. I am enclosing a PC formatted disk with GEDCOMs of my Dudley and Chandler databases for the SCGA files. Both files contain 12 to 14 generations.


The file that begins with Charles Dudley of Surry Co., contains 1017 individuals. Several hundred of the entrees sent to me by Jo Adams, do not contain dates or places, but they do show their relationship to the rest of the Dudley descendants. If you print out this file in genealogy outline form, it will be somewhere around 18 to 20 pages, depending on the font type and size used. The Chandler file contains 818 individuals.

I have finally broken down my Chandler brick wall and made the connection to William (and wife Delisha Cox Dobbins) Chandler who lived in that part of Surry Co. later to become Stokes Co., in the 1780 to 1795 period. The lineage begins with John Chandler who arrived in Jamestown in 1610 and passes through Surry and Stokes co. to Richard Chandler in Surry, Stokes, and Patrick Co., VA. Richard's son William was the father of my brick wall Thompson chandler. From that point my Chandler ancestry in Giles & Monroe Co., VA passes up the New River Valley to the Kanawha River to Kanawha Co. VA now WV.

By sheer luck, (and some hard work), in a trip to the VA archives in Richmond - the only place that has Personal Property tax records for Patrick Co. even the Patrick Co. Courthouse does not have them - I found a link of Thompson Chandler to William Chandler of Patrick Co. William had traveled to Monroe Co. VA/WV in the summer of 1810 and returned to Patrick Co. in the latter part of 1811. Thompson was born in VA to become WV in Feb. 1811. While in WV, William paid personal property tax once and signed a marriage bond for the granddaughter of John Thompson, Jarley Thompson to Jeremiah Ballard. This bond is recorded and I have copies, but the marriage certificate was never filed by the minister and does not appear on any marriage index. The marriage bond was on an unindexed film and by sheer luck, I happened to find it. I think the signing of the marriage bond by William, shows the closeness of the Chandler and Thompson families and explains the use of the name Thompson for William's son who was born a few months after the bond was signed.

Let me know if there is anything else that I can provide to you for your genealogy files. I appreciate your past help.

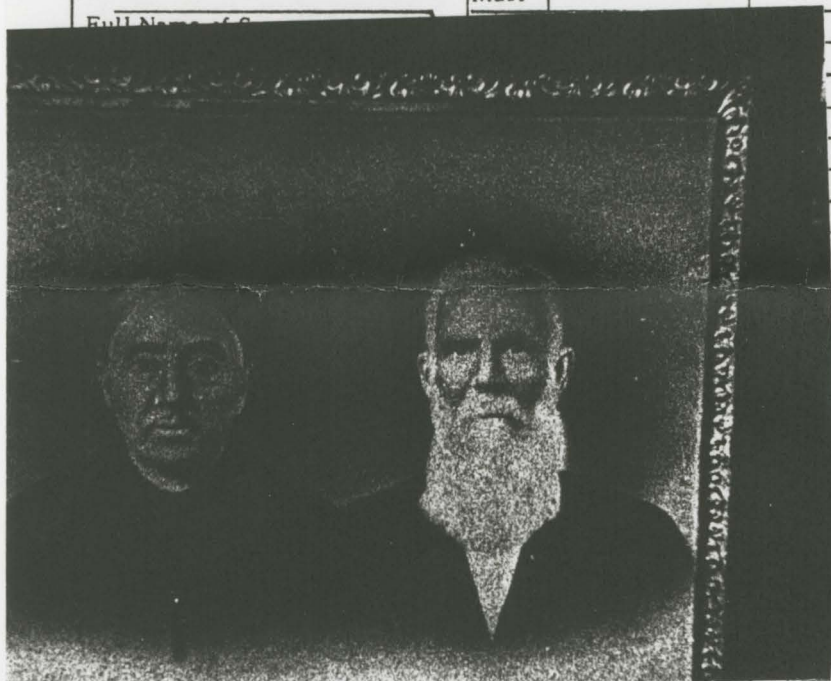

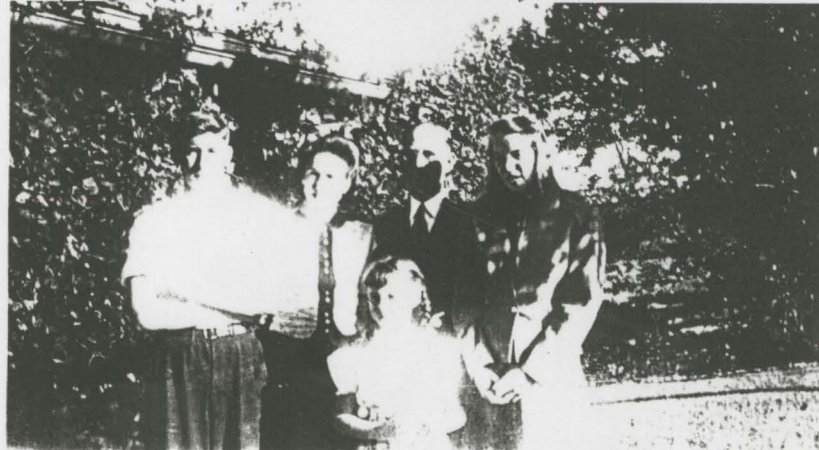

In the May newsletter is mentioned the new information on DUDLEY.

I am interested in a Dudley line which was in Sampson County in late 1700 to early 1800's at least. **Levi Dudley** made his will 11 January 1808. Included were daughters **Lydia, Nanney, Hepzibak, Lilly and Jennet** and sons **Elam, Ely, Enoch and John**. **Levi had a brother Eden and a Nedham Dudley** signed as a witness. Young Keen was also a witness.

Young Keen married Lydia Dudley before 1815 and they are said to be cousins. Lydia had 4 children and died. Young married twice more and his third wife is my line, but am trying to get "the cousin" part straightened out, so as to find Young's grandparents. His parents were John Keen and Elizabeth Curlee.

OUR DUDLEY COUSINS - Conclusion!

The children of Robert Dudley², iii through x, are listed on page 74 with the names of their spouses. We have no other information about them. Mrs. Don Adams (nee Jo Frances Jones) secured her facts about the descendants of Betsy Dudley and Harden Herring from an old family Bible in her possession.

One of my Fulwider cousins, Edwin Coble of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, not in anyway connected with the Dudley cousins, but out of the goodness of his heart and a natural bent for shaking family trees (as he calls it), has discovered the Dudley-Herring cemetery. But his discovery is best described in an excerpt of his letter of December 9, 1977:

Eureka! We found the Dudley-Herring cemetery!

I fully expected its location to be isolated, but I was not prepared to find it on a high promontory in the middle of a cow pasture overlooking Mt. Airy. (North Carolina)

Wednesday (Dec. 7) Kathleen and I visited the Don Adams', and they had contacted two other individuals who were interested in the search. We picked up Bruce Jones ... and from there we called on a Mrs. Simmons who also is related to Mrs. Adams and whose line ... connects with Betsy Dudley ... Mrs. Simmons led the party to an old man by the name of Roger Critz who lives alone in an isolated cabin. He pinpointed the location of the cemetery as being on a dairy farm across the way -- and off we went.

The dairy farmer was very cooperative and showed us where the graves were. The farm lay on a high ground, and the narrow, rutted road led us part of the way. We abandoned the car and walked ... across the frozen field, we made our way for a couple hundred yards in the bone chilling cold. Then we saw the five grave stones just past the thin grove of trees.

As I moved closer I compared myself with Stanley. Should I say: "Dudley-Herring cemetery, I presume?"

One of the stones was located several yards from the others and had no inscription. It was of soapstone made into a slab about 2 or 3 inches thick and about 12 or 16 inches wide. It protruded from the ground about two feet. We examined it thoroughly, made pencil rubbings on paper, but were unable to pick up any inscription.

The next two stones were somewhat larger and each had what we thought was a corresponding footstone. The first inscription we made out was:

Robt D Herring
was
Born May 1
1836
Died Sept 11 1867

The second: Harden G Herring
Was born 1792
Died Sept 18 1870

It was disappointing to find no Dudleys, but we are sure the graves are there. Time and the Holstein cows have taken their toll.

As the others began to move out I stood there for a moment reflecting on what a beautiful and quiet spot this must have been one hundred years ago. I made several shots with the camera and dug my hands deep into the fleece lined pockets of my jacket. Down below me came the low of the Holsteins, as the icy winds whipped across the lonely graves. It was gratifying to have found one more section of the puzzle ...

Charles Dudley, according to Mrs. Kegley, is believed to have immigrated to America about 1767 to Virginia, and later moved to North Carolina. The above dates were found in a very old Prayer Book and Psalms that once belonged to Charles Dudley. It is now in the possession of Mrs Hobart King (nee Ethel Poore), daughter of Charles Franklin Poore, the grandson of Charles Dudley's daughter Nancy who married Thomas Poore. Mrs. King lives in Ararat, Virginia. The writers of this book held the Prayer Book in our hands and copied the inscriptions it contained on August 4, 1977.

Charles Dudley is listed on the Taxable Property of Surry County, North Carolina in the year 1782, on page 13 as owning 4 horses and mules, 4 cattle and 200 acres of land. (Capt. Humphries District)

The 1790 Federal Census of Surry County, North Carolina on page 184 lists Charles Dudley with "2 free white males over 16 and 2 free white females over 16."

Robert Dudley was also buried in the Herring-Dudley graveyard.

On 10 25 1838, Jonathan Whitacur (Whitaker), as Executor in the right of his wife Nancy, filed a report of the sale which totaled \$203.37 3/4. One of the purchasers at that sale was Hardin Herring.

The above children produced a total of 72 grandchildren for Ransom Dudley and his "Jency." James Ransome was often referred to by his second name, Ransome or Ransom.

The marriage bond signed by Ransom Dudley and John Davis were "held and firmly bound unto John Branch Governor ... in the full sum of five hundred pounds, current money ... sealed with seals and dated this 26th day of April Anno Domini, 1818. THE CONDITION of the above obligation is such, That whereas the above bounden Ransom Dudley hath made application for a licensee for marriage to be celebrated between him and Jency Lyon ... Signed, sealed and delivered," etc.

The wealth of information that we have about James Ransome Dudley and his wife, Jane Mallory Lyon, and their descendents, comes from a privately published book by Marietta McWane Kegley when she was 77 years old. She was one of the 72 grandchildren, her mother being Eliza Hoge Dudley (see ix).

In writing about her grandparents, Mrs. Kegley quotes a letter from her cousin, Blanche Baskerville Moore as follows: "I remember my Grandmother well, even in old age, she bore evidence of being a beautiful woman, tall, and of fine carriage with the aqueline nose, thin lipped flexible mouth and the expressive eyes ... She was also a woman of unusual intelligence and business ability ... Grandmother's sister, Polly, was the mother of James and Stephen Wilkerson, Carrol County, Virginia. At one time Ransome Dudley was Sheriff of Surry County, North Carolina ... They moved to Virginia on horse-back. Grandmother rode a horse her father had given her and she traveled with two children behind her and one in her arms; Grandfather

carrying all of their effects on another horse. Grandfather's youngest brother, Billy Dudley, and his family, came with them and they all lived together in the same house on Deever's Place, afterwards Aaron Morgan's Place, between Newbern and Pulaski, near the foot of Peak Knob. Later Great-grandmother Dudley and her sisters, Charity Ross Fugate and Sarena Ross Sayers came also."

"Grandfather's family was at the Deever's Place only a short time when Grandmother and Aunt Polly Dudley had typhoid fever and were attended by Governor Floyd, who was a practicing physician. There was little money in the country at that time and most debts were paid in barter. In payment of the medical fee Grandma and Aunt Polly offered to weave some very fine linen for Governor Floyd's daughters. The offer was accepted and the weaving done. They carried the linen themselves to Mrs. Floyd, and she told each to select a cow and a calf from the herd, which they did. Aunt Mary was born at the Deever's Place and was named Mary Lavalett for Mrs. Floyd."

"Grandpa moved from the Deever's Place to 'Possum Hollow' and kept the tollgate on the road leading from Nashville, Tennessee to Washington, D.C. He later moved to Newbern and had a blacksmith shop and wagon stand, where the old Joe Anderson house now stands." (Ed note: The 1850 Federal Census shows Ransom to be a blacksmith. It also lists his son Charles as living with him and was a blacksmith too.) "At that time Grandpa bought from the Ingrams a log house of a single room, took it down and hauled the logs to Newbern and rebuilt it on the lot beside the house already there, with the chimney between them. He afterwards built an addition to the house containing kitchen and dining room. ... Their home was always open to the entertainment of friends; one of whom was Billy Hoge, who always brought with him several pounds of honey. Aunt Eliza McWane was named Eliza Hoge Dudley for his wife."

"Later Grandfather moved to Snowville, where he operated the first iron foundry in what is now Pulaski County. Grandfather moved to Wytheville several years prior to the War Between the States."

The letter above was included because it pictured the events and customs of those days so vividly.

In Mrs. Kegley's book she explains the connection between the Houston family and the Dudley family as follows:

"... Samuel Houston married Elizabeth Paxton, daughter of John Paxton, Rockbridge County, Virginia. Elizabeth Paxton's sister married a Lyon and her daughter Jane Mallory Lyon married Ransome Dudley ... The Samuel Houston's had ten children, one was General (or Governor or Senator) Sam Houston, Jr. Ransome named his tenth child for his wife's first cousin Matthew Houston of High Bridge (now called Natural Bridge) ... and his eleventh son Edward Paxton for the Paxton grandparents."

(Ed note: We have not had time to verify and document the Paxton family. This is another project that will find its way into an addendum or a Volume II.)

Charles Thomas Dudley (ii) perished in a hospital fire in Union Barracks.

James Ross Dudley (iii) was killed by a swarm of wasps at age 2 months.

In 1863 James Dudley enlisted in the Fort Lewis Volunteers (afterwards Company B), 4th Virginia Infantry, Confederate Army, from Pulaski County, for two years. Was discharged for disability.

Myrtle was buried in Radford, Virginia. Her cousin Essie (Maude Estelle Fulwider, now Mrs. Harry Lee Canfield) said in a letter written in 1977 at age 93, when she was recalling the past, *It must have been the first cemetery as it seems it was overgrown with plants (or weeds). The ground was covered with myrtle, like a carpet. I thought that was why my cousin Myrtle was buried there ... Nannie Smith and I and the younger ones would go there every day to play.*

The 1880 Federal Census lists Henry Dudley as living in Washington County, Virginia. He was a "railroad overseer." The census was taken on the 19th of June and the last child is listed as "unnamed" and being 1/12th of a year old and a "male." (See report below of 1900 census.)

The picture at the right was taken in Radford, Va., about 1890 or 1891. Front row: Blanche and Sue. 2nd row: John Henry Dudley, Frank and Frances Louise Fulwider (Mrs. J.H. Dudley). Back row: Edgar, Cora and Grace.



When John Henry Dudley had hair, it was red, as was his daughters Sue and Grace. Sue's hair was a bright red and she had the nickname of "Sunshine," while Grace's hair was an auburn shade. Their sister Cora had black hair and brown eyes. Cora was tiny, about five feet tall with an 18 inch waist. As the eldest daughter, Cora learned to sew at an early age. Her task was to make her brothers' shirts from age 12 until she married.

In 1895 R. T. Buckingham kept a diary while he was courting Miss Cora. The Dudley's did a lot of entertaining with croquet parties, suppers and refreshments after church meetings. (Reading the diary makes one wonder why our generation thinks life went at a slower pace back then!) RTB even took a trip to New York and stayed at the "Y" where Miss Cora wrote him letters. We have newspaper stories of the various weddings in which RTB and Miss Cora Dudley were attendants. The formal invitation to their wedding read as follows:

The 1900 census lists John Henry as a "conductor RR," son Frank as a "machinest RR shops," and their address: 739 Winchester Ave., Ashland, Kentucky and child born in 1880 was a daughter Grace. (See 1880 report above.)

Mrs. John Henry Dudley was better known as Fannie Dudley. She became a widow at about age 55. We think the picture at the right was taken shortly after her husband died. (We do not have the exact date of John Henry's death, which was probably due to a heart attack.)

She was affectionately called "Maw" by her Buckingham grandchildren. She was under 5 feet and never weighed over 90 pounds.

About a year after Fannie's husband died, their son Edgar died of TB. She had been nursing him for some time. Then their youngest child Blanche, (Mrs. Thomas Kay) contracted TB and Fannie took care of her until her death in 1910. She also took over the care and rearing of Blanche and Thomas Kay's small son, John Templeton Kay, whose picture is below.

"Maw" at about age 85 in Georgetown. After all her children and grandson Templeton were on their own, she would visit around with her daughters. The above picture was taken by grandson Lewis shortly before she went to daughter Sue's home where she became ill and died.

OUR DUDLEY COUSINS - Conclusion!

The children of Robert Dudley², iii through x, are listed on page 74 with the names of their spouses. We have no other information about them. Mrs. Don Adams (nee Jo Frances Jones) secured her facts about the descendants of Betsy Dudley and Harden Herring from an old family Bible in her possession.

One of my Fulwider cousins, Edwin Coble of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, not in anyway connected with the Dudley cousins, but out of the goodness of his heart and a natural bent for *shaking family trees* (as he calls it), has discovered the Dudley-Herring cemetery. But his discovery is best described in an excerpt of his letter of December 9, 1977:

Eureka! We found the Dudley-Herring cemetery!

I fully expected its location to be isolated, but I was not prepared to find it on a high promontory in the middle of a cow pasture overlooking Mt. Airy. (North Carolina)

Wednesday (Dec. 7) Kathleen and I visited the Don Adams', and they had contacted two other individuals who were interested in the search. We picked up Bruce Jones ... and from there we called on a Mrs. Simmons who also is related to Mrs. Adams and whose line ... connects with Betsy Dudley ... Mrs. Simmons led the party to an old man by the name of Roger Critz who lives alone in an isolated cabin. He pinpointed the location of the cemetery as being on a dairy farm across the way -- and off we went.

The dairy farmer was very cooperative and showed us where the graves were. The farm lay on a high ground, and the narrow, rutted road led us part of the way. We abandoned the car and walked ... across the frozen field, we made our way for a couple hundred yards in the bone chilling cold. Then we saw the five grave stones just past the thin grove of trees.

As I moved closer I compared myself with Stanley. Should I say:
"Dudley-Herring cemetery, I presume?"

One of the stones was located several yards from the others and had no inscription. It was of soapstone made into a slab about 2 or 3 inches thick and about 12 or 16 inches wide. It protruded from the ground about two feet. We examined it thoroughly, made pencil rubbings on paper, but were unable to pick up any inscription.

The next two stones were somewhat larger and each had what we thought was a corresponding footstone. The first inscription we made out was:

Robt D Herring	The second:	Harden G Herring
was		Was bornd 1792
Bornd May 1		Died Sept 18 1870
1836		
Died Sept 11 1867		

It was disappointing to find no Dudleys, but we are sure the graves are there. Time and the Holstein cows have taken their toll.

As the others began to move out I stood there for a moment reflecting on what a beautiful and quiet spot this must have been one hundred years ago. I made several shots with the camera and dug my hands deep into the fleece lined pockets of my jacket. Down below me came the low of the Holsteins, as the icy winds whipped across the lonely graves. It was gratifying to have found one more section of the puzzle ...

The FULWIDER Family

It is ironic that the only grandparent whom the co-author knew, Frances Louise Fulwider (Mrs. John Henry Dudley), belongs to the one family that can be traced back only one generation.

A brief History of the Dudley Family by Naoma Dudley Stone

Charles Dudley - born 21 Dec. 1750 as recorded in his Anglican Church prayer Book and Psalms - place unknown. Oral tradition suggest he migrated from London England as a teen-aged boy, but there is no proof of this.

Charles first wife was Mary and his second wife was Elizabeth. Nothing is known of the line of Judith or Mary. Nancy married Thomas Moore and her descendants preserved the prayer book containing the vital dates of birth, - no death dates were recorded.

Our Dudley branch is descended from Charles son, Robert, who married his cousin Clarissa Ross.

Charles was reportedly in the Battle of Shallow Ford in Surry County.

Battle of Shallow Ford

The Revolutionary War Battle of Shallow Ford occurred on October 14, 1780 in old Surry (now Yadkin) County, North Carolina. Approximately 310 Whig (those fighting for independence) militiamen from North Carolina and Virginia, commanded by Major Joseph Cloyd, defeated a band of Tories (those loyal to England) numbering 400 to 900 under Cols. Gideon and Hezekiah Wright. Occurring a week after the Patriot victory at King Mountain, it played an important role in turning the tide of the war in North Carolina to the advantage of the Patriots.

A brief history of the Dudley Family contributed by Naoma Dudley Sloan "Robert told his children that he was born in Caroline County, VA. We, therefore, know that his Father, Charles, was in Virginia before migrating to Surry County, NC and raised his family there. His first land grant Warrent of survey is dated Nov. 21, 1777 in Surry Co. Three other grants at various dates, were issued totaling about 1000 acres. The Dudley families lived in Surry Co., NC untill about 1828. At that time the great westward movement had begun and free government land was available for the asking. Robert's three sons left Surry County, NC with the intent of moving westward into new territory. Most of the daughters remained in Surry or migrated later as they married.

Robert and Clarissa had 10 living children: James Ransom, Mary, William Partham, Elizabeth, Nancy, Charles, Clarissa, Judith, Frances, and Celia.

James Ransom Dudley and William Parham Dudley came into Montgomery County, VA circa 1828-1829 and settled there due to the hardship of traveling with young children. The youngest brother Charles and wife Ann continued into IN territory and are there recorded in the Monroe Co. census of 1850 with 8 children. Pulaski became a VA County in 1838 and was a part of the original Montgomery County. These two counties contain many descendants of James R. and William P. Dudley today. A part of William Parham Dudley's family moved to Tazewell County circa 1858 and descendants are to be found there and in Bluefield, WV."

I appreciate your efforts and the information that you sent to me. I will send for the Stokes County and Surry County maps as you suggested. They will serve to give me an idea of the area I am researching. I am also pleased to forward an application and check for \$15 to join your Society. While I will not be able to attend meetings, I look forward to reading your SCGA Journal. I plan to visit the Surry area sometime this year and I will look up your back copies in the Surry Community College Library. In the mean time, if any copies of back issues are available, I would be pleased to purchase them.

Reference the Dudley family, I am enclosing the information you requested plus copies of Ransome Dudley's marriage certificate and Charles Dudley's Prayer Book that is inscribed with information. The prayer book copy was provided to me by Bettie McCaleb of Fayette, AL. She also sent me copies of pages 74-95 of a book "Prologue by Richard and Muriel Buckingham. This book seems to be definitive on the Dudleys. I have not yet entered all the information in my data base, but I have connected it to Ransome Dudley and his descendants (information I already had). Sorry to say, I believe the information I am sending disproves the rather exciting story of Robert Dudley and his inheritance.

I received Mrs. McCaleb's name and address from June Barnes who was provided my e-mail address by Linda Sorrell (I believe she is the web site coordinator?). It turns out that June and I are distant cousins. She is descended from one of Robert Dudley's sons and I am descended from another. Reference Ransom Dudley and his wife, it is interesting to note that on his marriage certificate he uses his middle name and his wife uses a nickname. I have found this type of name uses in several other cases. It really confuses research, but perhaps that just makes it more challenging.

Reference the Chandler Family, I have written a "think paper" (copy enclosed) based on my computer research and that of a Franklin Co. VA genealogist, which more clearly shows why I think Thompson Chandler's father was from Surry. I was pleased with the information you provided on Isaac Chandler and William Chandler. There is confusion with the Surry and Stokes County Chandlers. Two different groups. The Chandler Family Association (CFA) has done extensive research on the Chandlers of VA and NC. The Stokes Chandler descendants are known past the time of my Thompson Chandler, so they are not his parents although surely they were cousins. The Surry William Chandlers' (there were two, probably father and son) children are not listed in the CFA research. I am

enclosing copies of the pages of the CFA newsletter that concern the Surry and Stokes branches. Perhaps, for your library, you might want to purchase the back copies of the CFA news letters that start with the Chandlers in 1610 and show the connection to the Surry Chandlers. If so, let me know and I will send you their address.

Dudley Shoals, is a community on Upper Little River in se Caldwell Co. Dudley's Island is e Onslow County in the mouth of White Oak River at Bogue Inlet. This information is probably not useful but interesting to know they exist.

I hope you have received your Surry and Stokes historical maps that I suggested and that you were happy with them.
