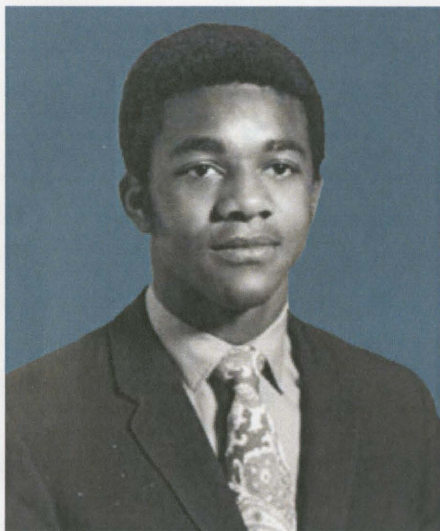

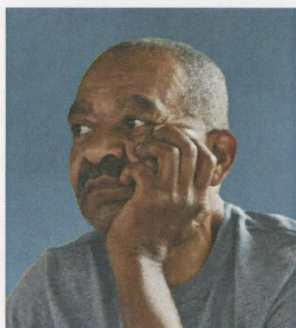
Obituary
