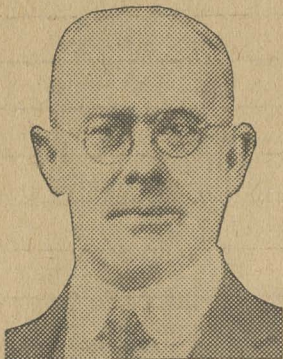

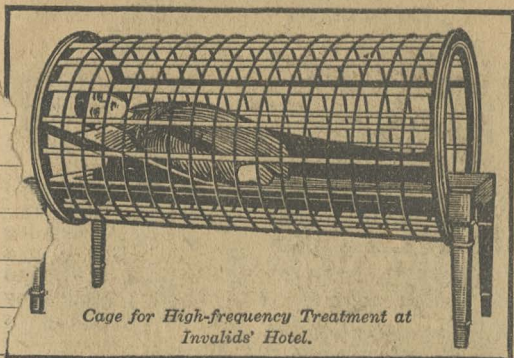

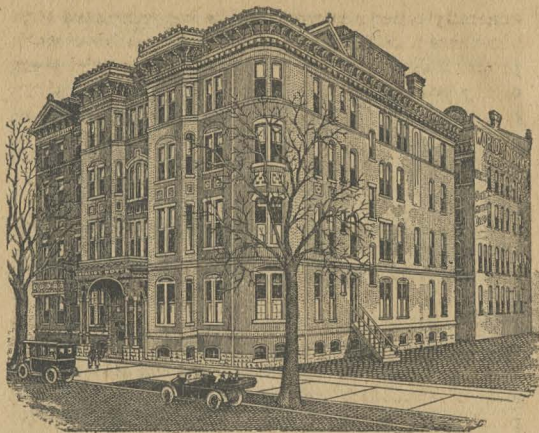

generally called a hospital and he has associated with him there a body of men and women similar to work people, foremen and managers of any industrial plant or dry goods store.
