

a squad of Enrolled Missouri Militia under Lt. Alex Kissee and a troop of confederate soldiers. Fought on the banks of Swan Creek, the confederate losses in this skirmish were reported to have been great in number.

During this period of Civil War the homes of isolated settlers in the Ozarks were terrorized by maurauding guerillas, bandits, and by both northern and southern troops. Horses and mules were pressed into service and livestock was butchered and eaten without compensation for the needy owners. The settlers who were fortunate enough to get by without meeting a sudden and violent death faced the very real hardship of trying not to starve to death.

Bushwhackers became more and more prevalent. Killings were the order of the day in this frightening, violent era of Ozarks' history. Many Ozarks' settlers fled their homes. In 1860 at the war's outbreak the population of Christian County was 5,491 persons but by 1865 it numbered

Later he served in the 16th Missouri Cavalry and fought in such other major battles as Jefferson City, Boonville, Lexington, and Big Blue (where he was wounded). After the war he served as a county Judge of Christian County.

I, JAMES MILIS, of the State of Tennessee and Court of Lincoln, being at this time weak of body, but of sound mind and disposing memory, do make and ordain this to be my Last will and testament, revoking all other wills. And as touching the Estate property or effect it has pleased God to bless me with, I Leave, bequeath and give in the following manner,:

First, I desire that all the money that is owing to me be collected by my executors and all my Just debts be paid, the money I now have on hand to also go to settle up my bus-

iness and pay my expenses.

Second, my desire is that my wife Elinor, have all the peoperty she brought here, to wit: a cow and calf, Bed and furniture and one bedstead. I have Given her a Black mare which she claims and twenty-five Dollars in money, she can also either take choice of a sow and pigs or Bureaus.

Third, My desire is that all my Land be sold on a credit of one, two and three years, and all my other property of every description be sold on a twelve months' credit, and the

(308) money therein arising, be equally divided between my children, to wit: Sarah Cunningham, Eliza N. Ashby, James W.Mills, Nancy C. Mills, Margaret Adeline Mills and Elizabeth Ann Mills, subject to the following deductions, viz, Sarah Cunningham has had a twenty-five dollar saddle, three Dollars in a bureau and five Dollar bedstead, a cow and feather bed to be deducted from her part. Eliza N. Ashby has had a bedstead, bed and furniture, a twenty-five dollar Saddle and a cow to be deducted from her part. James W. Mills has had a twenty-five Dollar saddle to be deducted from his part and Nancy C. has had a twenty-two dollar saddle to be deducted from her part.

Fourth, my will and desire is that Henie Johnson and Samuel Brown Esq. execute this will May 31st 1847. Acknowledged upon us the day it bears date.
