Witnesseth That whereas on or about the
26 Day of May 1909 the said Abram Evans
for and in consideration of the sum
of Fifteen Dollars to him in hand paid
by the said G. W. Hawks, did sell and
convey to the said G. W. Hawks a certain
Tract of land in the County of Alleghany
State of North Carolina on the waters of
Big Pine Creek adjoining the lands of
Abram Evans and George Coomer and
others and bounded as follows

Beginning on a Chestnut in Abram Evans
line on top of the mountain then Running
W 110 Poles to a Chestnut Oak Bush
Abram Evans and George Coomer corner
then S 112 Poles to a Chestnut Oak
Then East 108 Poles to W. M. Evans Line
to a Spanish Oak Sapling then to the
Beginning 112 Poles containing ⁶³

premises together with the further consideration
of \$15.00 Dollars Fifteen Dollars to him in
hand paid by the said G. W. Hawks

these presents doth grant release and
conferme quit blaine unto The said G. W.
Hawks his heuse and assigns all his
Right blaine interest and property
in and to the said tract of land above
discribed to have and to hold together
with all appurtenance thereto belonging
or in any wise appertain to him The
said G. W. Hawks and his heuse and
assigns free from any encumbrance
or intencement wherof the said Abram
Crany and wife has here unto set
their hands and seals The date above
written.
