Valentine Holyfield was one of three brothers - the other two being named William and Daniel - who were said to have come from Scotland to America before the American Revolution. A connection with Scotland has not been verified, but in May 1669 a Valentine Holyfield was in Kineton, Warwickshire, England. At that time he and his wife, Elizabeth, had a daughter, Ann, baptized.

Another Valentine was the earliest person bearing the surname on record in the American colonies. On April 9, 1721, Ralph, the illegitimate son of Valentine Hollyfield and Elizabeth Gilly was so christened at St. Arme's Protestant Episcopal Church, Annapolis, Maryland.

On April 2, 1776, a Valentine Holderfield enlisted in the 5th South Carolina Regiment; it is not known if this was the Surry County, North Carolina, Valentine.

A Valentine Holderfield was married to Henny Nolan in Rowen County, North Carolina, April 13, 1789. In 1790 Valentine was listed as the head of a family in that county. He probably died prior to 1800, since an Eleanor Holderfield, probably his widow, was listed as the head of the family at that time.

A story is told of the three brothers who are said to have come from Scotland that after the family arrived in American their parents died. It is said that they were raised by a man who mistreated them; this may have been in Virginia. The date of Valentine a birth is unknown, but his brother Daniel is said to have been born in 1754. Valentine married his wife Sussanah in Wake County, North Carolina, in 1774. According to a statement made by Susannah late in her life, they were married by Signal Jones, and "the manner of marriage was then by publishing." Susannah was born c. 1756, and according to her statement, had been a resident of Surry County since a 1759. After their marriage Susannah and Valentine settled in Surry County where he received a 200 acre land grant on Fishers River, entered October 23, 1781, granted lovember 3, 1784. He was a blacksmith. He died Mirch 8, 1820, and she died

valentine served in the Army during the Revolutionary War five years or more prior to his discharge August 17, 1781. At least part of this time he served as a private in a company commanded by a Captain Meredith. Valentine participated in the battles of Kings Mountain, October 7, 1780, and Guilford Court House, March 17, 1781. Under an 1831 statute which granted pensions to widows of veterans of the Revolutionary War Susannah applied for and received a pension of twenty dollars per year. The pension was issued December 14, 1842, and she received a total of \$240 since it was retroactive to 1831. On May 6, 1841, Susannah described herself as being quite helpless and unable to attend court on behalf of her pension claim; instead, a statement from her was read in court.

He was a member of the 1st Company, 8th Regiment, North Carolina Militia detached from the 1st Surry Regiment, during the War of 1812. He had received two Surry County land grants totalling 150 acres. The first, a 100 acre tract, was entered March 14, 1816, granted December 6, 1816; the second, 50 acres, was entered February 10, 1830, granted December 5, 1831.
 - (4) VALENTINE HOLYFIELD, born 1782, died 1820-30. Married (a) ALCEY HECKEPECK by Surry County marriage bond dated October 24, 1803; the bondsman was Solomon Harris. After her death he married (b) SALLY WHOTAN by Surry County marriage bond dated December 8, 1806; the bondsman was Jonathan Dyer.

- (5) DANIEL HOLYFIELD, born 1784, died 1810-19. Married ELIZABETH ALLEN by Wilkes County, North Carolina, marriage bond dated December 22, 1807; the bondsman was William Noland. She was born c. 1790, the daughter of Samuel Allen of Wilkes County. After Daniel's death she married WILLIAM FERGUSON by Wilkes County marriage bond dated March 4, 1819; the bondsman was William Noland. In 1860 she was living with her son Joseph Holyfield in Haywood County.
- Deniel was a member of the 5th Regiment, North Carolina Militia, during the War of 1812.
- (6) SUSANNAH HOLYFIELD, born 1786, died 1841-52.
- (7) JEMIMA HOLYFIELD, born 1788, died after 1850. Married to JAMES KYLE by Surry County marriage bond dated June 26, 1808; the bondsman was Edwin Chaffin.
- (8) WATSON HOLYFIELD, born March 18, 1791. Married MARGARITE VENABLE ("Peggy")

 December 29, 1814, at William Venable's, by Surry County marriage bond dated

 December 21, 1814; the bondsman was Relph Holyfield. She was born November 22,

 1789, died April 23, 1854.

He served in the War of 1812, enlisting in Captain George L. Davidson's Company, North Carolina Artillery, February 1, 1814, in Salisbury, North Carolina. He was honorably discharged September 4, 1814. The company was attached to the 7th Regiment of Detached Militia from North Carolina.

He received a total of thirty land grants in Surry County from 1818 until 1861, totalling 2209.2 acres. Two of these, totalling 213 acres, were granted jointly to him and H. C. Hampton in 1852. The tracts ranged in size from 3.9 acres to 125 acres. In addition he received two 80 acre tracts as a result of his war service. The first was granted under an act of September 28, 1850. He had disposed of this by 1855, and was granted the second tract under an act of March 3, 1855.

He was a blacksmith and carried on that trade as late as 1870.

A manuscript probably copied from a newspaper, is in the possession of one of his descendants and gives the following information about him: " . Grant (proprietor of one of the first hotels in Rockford, Surry County) had a son and also had with him in his employ, a boy by the name of Watson Holyfield about the Grant boy's size (this was told me by said Holyfield in his old age). One evening Grant sent the boys out on Fish River after some whiskey They did not get back until after dark. Mrs. Grant told the boys to repair to the kitchen (just in rear of hotel) and get their supper. They did so and on entering the kitchen they captured a large fat o'possum. Watson Holyfield in later years told the author of the article that while staying with Grant, Aaron Burr on his but one of fine natural common, sound sense, he was a good practical surveyor, though he "knew not A, " and surveyed thousands of acres of land for the people of Surry. He was a peculiar man, loved his dram, and would take his sprees, but would never begin one by himself, but would always ask a friend to take a was extensively known".

He was a blacksmith, and was described as a man of great strength. In 1861 he was a notary public of Polk County, Missouri. He enlisted in the U. S. Army July 10, 1861, at Springfield, Missouri. He served as a scout for General Sigel in the 3rd Division, Army of the West; his pay was five dollars a day. On August 12, 1861, while retreating from Springfield after the Battle of Wilson Creek he contracted eczema which left him unable to do manual labor. He continued in the Army until March 23, 1865.

Since 1865 they resided in Montgomery County, Kansas, and Carroll County, Arkansas. He applied for a pension ranking with pay of a lieutenant colonel as a result of his service. Senator Ingalls introduced a bill in the Senate, and Representative B. W. Perkins introduced one in the House of Representatives to grant him a pension before September 1, 1885, but neither was successful.

They were buried at Snow Hill Baptist Church, Surry County. His gravestone gives the name as "Holyfield", while hers bas "Holderfield".

Letty (4) INFITIA HOLYFIELD, born September 21, 1837, died March 7, 1919. Married to WILLIAM MASON NORMAN March 22, 1860, by D. M. Cooper, J. P., at her father's house. He was the son of Anna Catherine Wolff and Clemmons Norman, born October 14, 1833, died June 6, 1905. They were buried at Rockford Baptist Church.

After graduating from a school in Hillsville, Virginia, in 1852 he taught in several schools in North Carolina and Virginia until 1855. In 1855 he went to Missouri, Iowa, returning to North Carolina in 1858. He studied law and in 1859 was licensed to practice law.

On May 4, 1861, at Dobson he enlisted in a company known as the Surry Regulators which was later attached to the 22nd Regiment, N. C. Troops. He became a sergeant inthis company, and on July 8, 1861, was elected 1st lieutenant. In September 1861, the company became Company A, 28th Regiment, N. C. Troops, and he was elected its captain. The company was reorganized in April 1862 and he left the service due to 111 health. He was recalled in August and became 1st lieutenant in Company A, 2nd Regiment, N. C. Troops. In June 1863 he was promoted to captain of the company, due to the death of the previous captain. He and his company were captured at Kellyeford, Virginia, November 7, 1863. He was imprisoned on Johnson's Island, in lake Eric near Sandusky, Ohio, from November 14, 1863, until the end of the war at which time he was released and allowed to walk home.

After returning to Surry County he became a farmer, surveyor, and a justice of the peace. The book "A Portion of My Life", Winston-Salem, N. C., John F. Blair, Publisher, 1959, is a reprint of the autobiographical manuscript he wrote while imprisoned on Johnson's Island.

At that time his height was 5'll"; he had fair complexion, blue eyes, and light hair. He was wounded nine times during the war.

He was a farmer and operated a mill across from Rockford on the Yadkin River. He also operated a ferry on the river. They were buried at Rockford Baptist Church.
