Valentine Holyfield was one of three brothers - the other two being named William and Daniel - who were said to have come from Scotland to America before the American Revolution. A connection with Scotland has not been verified, but in May 1669 a Valentine Holyfield was in Kineton, Warwickshire, England. At that time he and his wife, Elizabeth, had a daughter, Ann, baptized.

Another Valentine was the earliest person bearing the surname on record in the American colonies. On April 9, 1721, Ralph, the illegitimate son of Valentine Hollyfield and Elizabeth Gilly was so christened at St. Anne's Protestant Episcopal Church, Annapolis, Maryland.

On April 2, 1776, a Valentine Holderfield enlisted in the 5th South Carolina Regiment; it is not known if this was the Surry County, North Carolina, Valentine.

A Valentine Holderfield was married to Henny Nolan in Rowan County, North Carolina, April 13, 1789. In 1790 Valentine was listed as the head of a family in that county. He probably died prior to 1800, since an Eleanor Holderfield, probably his widow, was listed as the head of the family at that time.

A story is told of the three brothers who are said to have come from Scotland that after the family arrived in America their parents died. It is said that they were raised by a man who mistreated them; this may have been in Virginia. The date of Valentine's birth is unknown, but his brother Daniel is said to have been born in 1754. Valentine married his wife Susannah in Wake County, North Carolina, in 1774. According to a statement made by Susannah late in her life, they were married by Sigral Jones, and "the manner of marriage was then by publishing." Susannah was born c. 1756, and according to her statement, had been a resident of Surry County since c. 1769. After their marriage Susannah and Valentine settled in Surry County where he received a 200 acre land grant on Fishers River, entered October 23, 1781, granted November 3, 1784. He was a blacksmith. He died March 8, 1820, and she died March 3, 1844.

Valentine served in the Army during the Revolutionary War five years or more prior to his discharge August 17, 1781. At least part of this time he served as a private in a company commanded by a Captain Meredith. Valentine participated in the battles of Kings Mountain, October 7, 1780, and Guilford Court House, March 17, 1781. Under an 1831 statute which granted pensions to widows of veterans of the Revolutionary War Susannah applied for and received a pension of twenty dollars per year. The pension was issued December 14, 1842, and she received a total of \$240 since it was retroactive to 1831. On May 6, 1841, Susannah described herself as being quite helpless and unable to attend court on behalf of her pension claim; instead, a statement from her was read in court.

Children of Susannah and Valentine Holyfield:

- (1) MARY HOLYFIELD, born 1776, died in infancy. She may have been nicknamed Polly.
- (2) WILLIAM HOLYFIELD, born 1778, died 1846, unmarried. In his will he bequeathed all of his property to Elizabeth Walker. He owned 150 acres on which she lived, and another 100 acres on Double Creek. The latter was a land grant he had entered March 17, 1817, received November 24, 1818.
- (3) RALPH HOLYFIELD, born June 9, 1781, died 1850-52, unmarried. In 1850 he lived with his brother Watson and was a miller. He was a member of the 1st Company, 8th Regiment, North Carolina Militia detached from the 1st Surry Regiment, during the War of 1812. He had received two Surry County land grants totalling 150 acres. The first, a 100 acre tract, was entered March 14, 1816, granted December 6, 1816; the second, 50 acres, was entered February 10, 1830, granted December 5, 1831.
- (4) VALENTINE HOLYFIELD, born 1782, died 1820-30. Married (a) ALCEY HECKEPECK by Surry County marriage bond dated October 24, 1803; the bondsman was Solomon Harris. After her death he married (b) SALLY WHOTAN by Surry County marriage bond dated December 8, 1806; the bondsman was Jonathan Dyer.

- (5) DANIEL HOLYFIELD, born 1784, died 1810-19. Married ELIZABETH ALLEN by Wilkes County, North Carolina, marriage bond dated December 22, 1807; the bondsman was William Noland. She was born c. 1790, the daughter of Samuel Allen of Wilkes County. After Daniel's death she married WILLIAM FERGUSON by Wilkes County marriage bond dated March 4, 1819; the bondsman was William Noland. In 1860 she was living with her son Joseph Holyfield in Haywood County.

Daniel was a member of the 5th Regiment, North Carolina Militia, during the War of 1812.

- (6) SUSANNAH HOLYFIELD, born 1786, died 1841-52.
- (7) JEMIMA HOLYFIELD, born 1788, died after 1850. Married to JAMES KYLE by Surry County marriage bond dated June 26, 1808; the bondsman was Edwin Chaffin.
- (8) WATSON HOLYFIELD, born March 18, 1791. Married MARGARITE VENABLE ("Peggy") December 29, 1814, at William Venable's, by Surry County marriage bond dated December 21, 1814; the bondsman was Ralph Holyfield. She was born November 22, 1789, died April 23, 1854.

He served in the War of 1812, enlisting in Captain George L. Davidson's Company, North Carolina Artillery, February 1, 1814, in Salisbury, North Carolina. He was honorably discharged September 4, 1814. The company was attached to the 7th Regiment of Detached Militia from North Carolina.

He received a total of thirty land grants in Surry County from 1818 until 1861, totalling 2209.2 acres. Two of these, totalling 213 acres, were granted jointly to him and H. C. Hampton in 1852. The tracts ranged in size from 3.9 acres to 125 acres. In addition he received two 80 acre tracts as a result of his war service. The first was granted under an act of September 28, 1850. He had disposed of this by 1855, and was granted the second tract under an act of March 3, 1855.

He was a blacksmith and carried on that trade as late as 1870.

A manuscript probably copied from a newspaper, is in the possession of one of his descendants and gives the following information about him: " Grant (proprietor of one of the first hotels in Rockford, Surry County) had a son and also had with him in his employ, a boy by the name of Watson Holyfield about the Grant boy's size (this was told me by said Holyfield in his old age). One evening Grant sent the boys out on Fish River after some whiskey They did not get back until after dark. Mrs. Grant told the boys to repair to the kitchen (just in rear of hotel) and get their supper. They did so and on entering the kitchen they captured a large fat o'possum. Watson Holyfield in later years told the author of the article that while staying with Grant, Aaron Burr on his return from a trip south, put up for the night with Grant and seeing young Holyfield offered to take him and educate him; but he would not go. "And that was where I missed it". Young Holyfield grew to manhood and served in the army in the war against the Seminole Indians. He was an uneducated man, but one of fine natural common, sound sense, he was a good practical surveyor, though he "knew not A, " and surveyed thousands of acres of land for the people of Surry. He was a peculiar man, loved his dram, and would take his sprees, but would never begin one by himself, but would always ask a friend to take a drink with him which would give him a start. He called himself "the Duke and was extensively know".

- (9) NELLY HOLYFIELD, born 1793, died 1866-67, unmarried.
- (10) ELIZABETH HOLYFIELD, born 1796, died 1870-80. Married JAMES REID by Surry County marriage bond dated November 2, 1825; the bondsman was James York.
- (11) JOHN HOLYFIELD, born 1798, died after 1860. Married MAHALIA CADLE by Surry County marriage bond dated August 3, 1819; the bondsman was William Watson. She was born c 1802, died after 1860.

Son of Alcey Heckepeck and Valentine Holyfield:

ISAAC HOLYFIELD, born c. 1804. Married (a) CYNTHIA -----, born c. 1801. Married (b) NANCY or RACHAEL PERRY December 27, 1856, by W. D. Rutledge in Surry County. She was born c. 1803 in Virginia. The family lived in Surry County in 1850, Grayson

County, Virginia, in 1860.

Children of Sally Whotan and Valentine Holyfield:

- (1) WILLIAM HOLYFIELD, born c. 1811. Married ROSANA EVANS by Surry County marriage bond dated June 2, 1832; the bondsman was Burgess Wood.
- (2) ELEANOR HOLYFIELD, born 1811-15. Married to CHARLES BULLEN by Surry County marriage bond dated February 11, 1835; the bondsman was Bird Wood.
- (3) VALENTINE HOLYFIELD, born c. 1820. Married NANCY O'NEAL, born c. 1820, died prior to 1880. In 1880 he was a miller living with the family of his daughter, Mrs. John M. Hiatt.

Children of Elizabeth Allen and Daniel Holyfield:

- (1) SAMUEL HOLYFIELD, born c. 1810, died 1870-80. Married to (a) LUCINDA BRYANT by Haywood County marriage bond dated January 23, 1834, the bondsman was Solomon Ray. She was born in South Carolina c. 1812, died 1850-51. Married to (b) JANE McCLURE July 14 1851, by J. A. McClure. Jeremiah Vickers was the bondsman for the marriage bond of the same date. The family lived near the Crabtree post office, Haywood County.
- (2) MATILDA HOLYFIELD, married to THOMAS MILNER by Haywood County marriage bond dated November 20, 1833. the bondsman was Thomas A. Noland.
- (3) JOSEPH HOLYFIELD, born c. 1814, unmarried. He lived with his mother in 1860, and with the family of his niece Mrs. John Morrow in 1870 and 1880.

Children of Margarite Venable and Watson Holyfield:

- (1) HARDIN HOLYFIELD, born January 21, 1816, died 1863-65. Married to PAULINA BUTCHER December 27, 1832, by Surry County marriage bond of the same date. the bondsman was Benjamin F. Bray. She was born c. 1815, died 1876-77. He was a constable in 1850, and a keeper of the poor in 1860. He was said to have died while carrying supplies to the troops during the Civil War.
- (2) JAMES HOLYFIELD, born July 6, 1818.
- (3) ELIZABETH HOLYFIELD, born February 16, 1820. Married to WESLEY WHITAKER by Surry County marriage bond dated December 6, 1837; the bondsman was Anderson Whitaker.

(4) MARY HOLYFIELD, born May 3, 1822.

(5) LEWIS VALENTINE HOLYFIELD, born May 18, 1824, died after 1885. Married MARY ----- November 5, 1846, Laurel County, Kentucky. She was born c. 1832.

He was a blacksmith, and was described as a man of great strength. In 1861 he was a notary public of Polk County, Missouri. He enlisted in the U. S. Army July 10, 1861, at Springfield, Missouri. He served as a scout for General Sigel in the 3rd Division, Army of the West; his pay was five dollars a day. On August 12, 1861, while retreating from Springfield after the Battle of Wilson Creek he contracted eczema which left him unable to do manual labor. He continued in the Army until March 23, 1865.

Since 1865 they resided in Montgomery County, Kansas, and Carroll County, Arkansas. He applied for a pension ranking with pay of a lieutenant colonel as a result of his service. Senator Ingalls introduced a bill in the Senate, and Representative B. W. Perkins introduced one in the House of Representatives to grant him a pension before September 1, 1885, but neither was successful.

- (2) MARTIN R. HOLYFIELD, born c. 1828, died 1861-70. Married JANE ODIER by Surry County marriage bond dated August 5, 1847; bondsman was John Holyfield. She was born c. 1830. He enlisted in Company B, 2nd Battalion, N. C. Infantry, C. S. A., October 25, 1861.
- (3) WILLIAM HOLYFIELD, born c. 1838.
- (4) JEFFERSON HOLYFIELD, born July 7, 1841, died October 14, 1913. Married MARY ANN TUGGLE by Surry County marriage bond dated May 28, 1859; the bondsman was Thomas J. Doss. She was born June 5, 1840, in Virginia, died December 16, 1906. He enlisted in Company H, 21st Regiment, N. C. Infantry, C. S. A., June 5, 1861, and was discharged in 1862. He was buried at a graveyard on his farm, and she was buried at Double Creek Church of Christ.

- (1) WILLIAM HOLYFIELD, born c. 1835, married LYDIA -----, born c. 1835. They lived in Grayson County, Virginia, in 1860, and in Surry County in 1880. He served in a Virginia unit in the Confederate Army during the Civil War.
- (2) MARY HOLYFIELD, born c. 1835.
- (3) ELIZABETH HOLYFIELD, born c. 1841.
- (4) NANCY HOLYFIELD, born c. 1842.
- (5) VALENTINE HOLYFIELD, born c. 1845, married in 1880. He enlisted in Company C, 63rd Virginia Infantry, C. S. A., November 12, 1863, at Chickamauga. He deserted June 26, 1864, near Marietta, and was later captured by Union forces in Green County, Virginia. He was sent to Military Prison, Louisville, Kentucky. He took the oath of allegiance to the United States at Chattanooga, Tennessee, July 16, 1864, and was released July 27, 1864, having agreed to remain north of the Ohio River during the war. At that time he was 5'9" tall, had sandy hair, and blue eyes. He was living in Surry County and was listed as a physician in 1880.
- (6) ISAAC HOLYFIELD, born c. 1848.

- (4) JOHN HOLYFIELD, born c. 1841, died January 26, 1865. He enlisted in the 11th Regiment, North Carolina Infantry (Volunteers), at Dobson on June 5, 1861. On November 14, 1861, the unit became Company H, 21st Regiment, N. C. Infantry, C. S. A. He was listed as sick in camp in the late summer and early autumn of 1861. He was admitted to Chimborazo Hospital No. 5, Richmond, Virginia, March 7, 1862, for a lumbar abscess. Early in 1863 he was promoted from private to 2nd corporal.

He was captured by Union Forces at Fredericksburg, Virginia, May 3, 1863. Apparently he rejoined his unit and was wounded in the leg at Gettysburg July 1, 1863. He was again taken prisoner, at Gettysburg, and was sent to Ft. McHenry, Baltimore, Maryland. On July 9, 1863, he was sent to Ft. Delaware, Delaware; on October 18, 1863, he was transferred from Ft. Delaware to Point Lookout, Maryland, where he died.

- (5) WILLIAM HOLYFIELD, born c. 1843. Enlisted in the 11th Regiment, N. C. Infantry (Volunteers), at Dobson June 5, 1861. On November 14, 1861, the unit became Company H, 21st Regiment, N. C. Infantry, C. S. A. He was listed as sick in camp in the autumn of 1861. His term of enlistment had been for one year, and on July 15, 1862, he re-enlisted for three years at Dobson.

He was admitted to General Hospital, Camp Winder, Richmond, October 18, 1862, with hepatitis. He was given a 30 day furlough November 5, 1862, and returned to duty March 10, 1863. He was wounded May 4, 1863, and was sent to 2nd Division, General Hospital, Camp Winder. He was declared unfit for duty July 29, 1864, due to frequent attacks of epilepsy; he was described as anemic and debilitated. He was discharged August 8, 1864.

- (1) ROSEY HOLYFIELD, born September 15, 1833, died October 4, 1850.
- (2) JAMES HOLYFIELD, born March 12, 1835, died September 13, 1860. He died from a fever which affected most of the family at that time. He was buried in the family burying ground near Rockford, and his grave was later marked by a stone erected by his younger brother, Thomas B. Holyfield. It remains the only legibly marked grave in the cemetery.

- (3) COLUMBUS C. HOLYFIELD, born May 19, 1836, died December 3, 1910. Married to CARY ANN SNOW July 12, 1866, by Rev. T. W. Davis. She was born February 25, 1846, died March 19, 1940, the daughter of Eliza Forkner and Byrd Snow.

In 1860 he was a horse trader, and a farmer in 1870 and 1880.

He enlisted in Company A, 28th Regiment, North Carolina Infantry, C. S. A., on June 4, 1861. *Became a sergeant in April, 1862*

They were buried at Snow Hill Baptist Church, Surry County. His gravestone gives the name as "Holyfield", while hers has "Holderfield".

- LEPITIA HOLYFIELD, born September 21, 1837, died March 7, 1919. Married to WILLIAM MASON NORMAN March 22, 1860, by D. M. Cooper, J. P., at her father's house. He was the son of Anna Catherine Wolff and Clemmons Norman, born October 14, 1833, died June 6, 1905. They were buried at Rockford Baptist Church.

After graduating from a school in Hillsville, Virginia, in 1852 he taught in several schools in North Carolina and Virginia until 1855. In 1855 he went to Missouri, Iowa, returning to North Carolina in 1858. He studied law and in 1859 was licensed to practice law.

On May 4, 1861, at Dobson he enlisted in a company known as the Surry Regulators which was later attached to the 22nd Regiment, N. C. Troops. He became a sergeant in this company, and on July 8, 1861, was elected 1st lieutenant. In September 1861, the company became Company A, 28th Regiment, N. C. Troops, and he was elected its captain. The company was reorganized in April 1862 and he left the service due to ill health. He was recalled in August and became 1st lieutenant in Company A, 2nd Regiment, N. C. Troops. In June 1863 he was promoted to captain of the company, due to the death of the previous captain. He and his company were captured at Kellysford, Virginia, November 7, 1863. He was imprisoned on Johnson's Island, in Lake Erie near Sandusky, Ohio, from November 14, 1863, until the end of the war at which time he was released and allowed to walk home.

After returning to Surry County he became a farmer, surveyor, and a justice of the peace. The book "A Portion of My Life", Winston-Salem, N. C., John F. Blair, Publisher, 1959, is a reprint of the autobiographical manuscript he wrote while imprisoned on Johnson's Island.

- (5) MARGARET HOLYFIELD, born May 5, 1839, died 1867-72. Married LACEY JASPER NORMAN September 15, 1858. He was a brother to William M. Norman, born February 8, 1829, died December 10, 1897. He was a captain in the Confederate Army.
- (6) WATSON BUTCHER HOLYFIELD, born May 9, 1841, died January 29, 1916. Married VIRGINIA FRANCES TURNER July 12, 1866, in Yadkin County, North Carolina. She was born April 29, 1840, died March 3, 1915, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Lewis C. Turner.

He enlisted in Company A, 28th Regiment, N. C. Infantry, C. S. A., May 4, 1861, in Dobson. On July 7, 1862, he was admitted to General Hospital No. 7, Richmond, Virginia, due to a shell wound he received on his right elbow at Jaines Mill on June 27; on July 9 he was given a thirty day furlough. He was promoted to first sergeant September 21, 1862. On May 7, 1864, he received a wound on his right hand, resulting in his admittance to Wayside Hospital or General Hospital No. 7, Richmond. He was sent to Winder Hospital, Richmond, May 14, and was admitted to the General Hospital, Danville, Virginia, May 18, receiving a furlough on the 23rd. After his return to duty he received a gunshot wound on his right shoulder in a battle at Reams Station, Virginia, August 25, 1864. The next day he was admitted to the General Hospital, Petersburg, Virginia, and was given a sixty day furlough September 22. He was retired from the service about February 1865, due to his last injury. At that time his height was 5'11"; he had fair complexion, blue eyes, and light hair. He was wounded nine times during the war.

He was a farmer and operated a mill across from Rockford on the Yadkin River. He also operated a ferry on the river. They were buried at Rockford Baptist Church.

- (7) MATILDA HOLYFIELD, born October 3, 1842. Married to STEPHEN DUNNAGAN January 4, 1866, by Rev. Isaac Davis. They went to Indiana or Illinois.
- (8) MARTHA A. HOLYFIELD, born June 10, 1844. Married to LACEY JASPER NORMAN December 26, 1872, by John Brown, J. P. at John Brown's residence. He had first married her sister Margaret.
- (9) JOHN HENRY HOLYFIELD, born May 13, 1846, died January 7, 1907. Married to FANNIE L. FOLGER October 25, 1876, by J. H. Cornelius, J. P., at M. Y. Folger's residence. She was born c. 1856.
- (10) DREWRY K. HOLYFIELD, born April 8, 1848. He went to Dallas, Texas, where he married. They had eleven daughters all of whom died in a typhoid fever epidemic.
- (11) HARDIN HOLYFIELD, born March 12, 1850. Married to AMELIA WALKER December 21, 1876, by Rev. Robert Posten, Baptist, at Jesse Walker's residence, Rutherford County. She was born June 20, 1843, died April 16, 1911. She was a sister to Sarah Ann Walker who married Noah Jay Hollifield. Noah and Harden were second cousins once removed.
