DOBSON — In 1930, Jesse Doss was walking down a road with some buddies when he noticed a pretty girl in a blue coat with a group of her friends out in front.

The boys made a game plan to talk to the girls.

"I told them, 'I want the one in the blue coat,'" Jesse, 98, said.

It was March, and Jesse found a pearl.

Three months later, June 22, Jesse and his gal Pearl became Mr. and Mrs. Doss.

"The Lord has blessed us," Jesse said Sunday at the Copeland Masonic Lodge during his and Pearl's 77th wedding anniversary.

Pearl sat beside her husband, opening the cards from family and reading them to Jesse. Both were soft-spoken, opting to watch as children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren filled the lodge with conversation and song.

"I used to be a good cook," Pearl, 97, said with a laugh. She said that could be one of the reasons her husband stuck with through the years.

For Jesse, the best part about finding Pearl surrounded him at the lodge.

"I reckon family, them gettin' along good," he said. "Raising boys and girls and having grandchildren."

The couple lived on a farm and had eight children and 14 grandchildren. One daughter, Jean Robertson, said there are

more great-grandchildren than she can count.

She said her parents were strong, and her mom ran a good home — even if it was a little strict.

"We were a little bit more afraid of her than Daddy," Robertson said laughing. "We could always get by with more with Daddy."

It was on Jesse and Pearl's 50th wedding anniversary that their family started gathering for an annual celebrations. The last Sunday in June is reserved for Jesse and Pearl.

The family hasn't missed one yet. Jesse and Pearl have been married

longer than any other living couple in Surry County, Robertson said. President George W. Bush sent the couple a signed letter a few years ago, and Willard Scott has talked about them on TV.

"They've been blessed," Robertson said. "That puts it in a nutshell."

During the Sunday celebration, as family members made plates from a buffet of chicken wings, cornbread, green beans and sweet potato

cobbler, Jesse and Pearl stuck close to each other. Their family hugged them, took pictures and made small talk.

As each approaches the century mark in age, they show signs of years taking their toll — Jesse doesn't hear as good as he used to, and Pearl's eyes aren't as sharp as they once were, the family said. But between the two, they said, the spark hasn't diminished a bit.

"I think as much of him today as I did then," Pearl said.

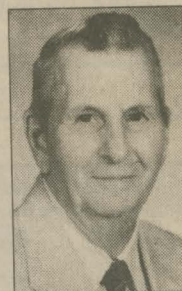
