In May of 1996, I visited this cemetery with distant relatives, Irene Bauguess Bowen and Ann Bauguess Groce. It is believed that besides Richard and Susan being buried there that this is the location of Richard's parents, Daniel and Patience (Franklin) Wright. As these graves are marked only by rocks at the head and foot, it is difficult to confirm this piece of information. However, their daughter Phoebe Wright Sale and husband, Martin Sale are buried at this cemetery, along with daughters, Susan Annolin and Dorah Bell Sale.

Notes for JOSEPH ANDREW WRIGHT:

Joseph Andrew "Joe Boy" Wright was a painter of signs most of his life. During World War II, he was too large to serve in the Army. At 6'4" tall and weighing close to 300 pounds, they had no uniforms to fit Joe. He had red hair and as a child a face full of freckles. He stood out amongst his peers in more ways than one.

He died 6 days before his 84th birthday of complications from Alzheimer's disease - a disease that plagued the Wright family it seems.

Joe is buried in the Bethel Church Cemetery in Arcadia along side of his wife of 52 years.

Notes for CLOTILE BRANTLEY:

Clo was known as a very sweet person. She never had children and would have made a wonderful mother. She was a favorite of her husband's nieces and nephews.

Clo died of Cancer of the Colon after a very short illness of approximately 40 days. She is buried along side of Joe in the Bethel Church Cemetery in Arcadia, Louisiana.

The home she and Joe built was on land that had been in the Brantley family for over 100 years.
