

Cornelia 'Neil' Nisbet Everett, 103, a resident of Sharon Towers, and widow of Herschel Hill Everett, died Thursday, March 8, 2001 at Sharon Towers.



Mrs. Everett was born January 24, 1898 in Kirkwood, GA., the daughter and youngest child of the late John E. Nisbet and Lula Sigmon Nisbet.

In addition to her parents, she was also predeceased by her five sisters and four brothers.

On April 6, 1918, Mrs. Everett married H.H. 'Heck' Everett in Atlanta, GA. A memorial service celebrating the life of Mrs. Everett will be held at 11:00 A.M. Monday, March 12, 2001, at Sharon Presbyterian Church with The Reverend Terry Hanna and The Reverend John L. Alexander officiating. Entombment will be private for the family in the Sharon Memorial Park Mausoleum. The family will receive friends following the memorial service at the church.

Mrs. Everett is survived by her daughter, Ann Everett Belk, and six grandchildren, Thomas Everett Belk and his wife, Donna, Paul Henderson Belk and his wife, Cecelia, Cornelia Belk, James Herschel Belk and his wife, Pam, Mary Belk Gordon, and Margaret Belk Shealy and her husband, Daniel.
