The Snow Family in Surry County, NC in the 1700s

The following families are the first documented Snows in what is today
Surry County, NC:

Snow Families that came to Surry County and then moved on:

- **1775 – Frostin Snow & son, Leonard Snow**
- **1778 – Isaac Snow & son, William Snow**

Snow Families whose descendants still reside in Surry County:

- **1765 – Henry Snow & son, Obediah Snow**
- **1787 – Frost_ & Snow, Sr. & son, Frost_ & Snow, Jr.**
- **1793 – Fielding Snow**

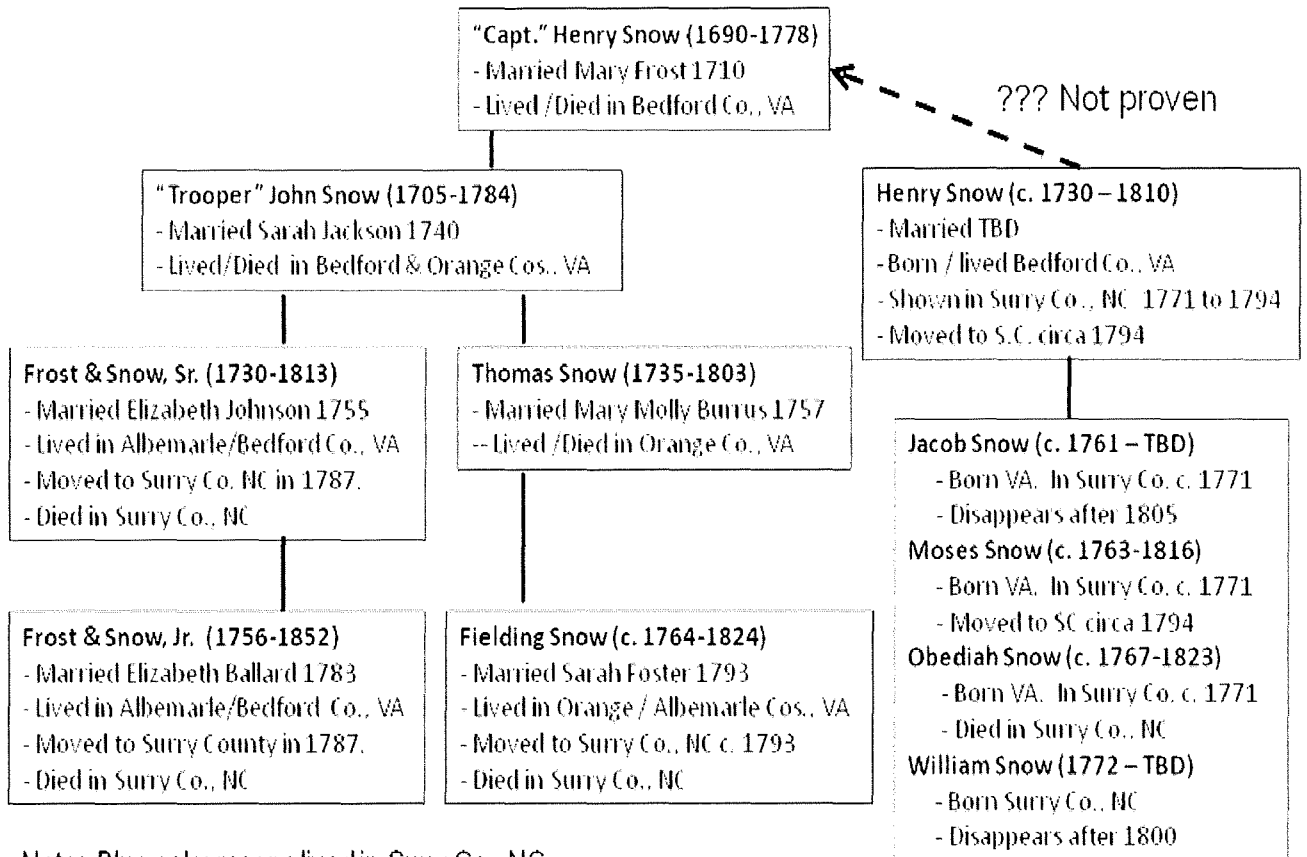
Frostin Snow & Leonard Snow (Yadkin River about 1775 - 1805)

- 1775, 1782, & 1789-93 - Surry Co. Tax Lists show Frostin Snow with 1 white poll (age 16 or older until 1784, when it became age 21 or older). He eventually owns 200 acres of land along the Yadkin River.
- 1794 - 97 - Surry Co. Tax Lists add Leonard Snow (Frostin's son) with 1 white poll (age 21 or over) with Frostin's listing.
- 1798 – 1800 - Surry Co. Tax Lists show Frostin Snow with 100 acres and Leonard Snow with 300 acres along the Yadkin River.
- 1800 Federal Census - Shows Frostin with 1 white males (wm) 45+ yrs. old; 1 wm 26-45; 3 wm 16-26; 3 wm < 10; 1 white female (wf) 45+; 1 wf 16-26; 1 wf 10-16. Leonard is 1 wm 26-45 and 1 wf 16-26. Frostin disappears hereafter from Surry Co. records.
- 1802 & 1804 - Surry Co. Court records mention Leonard as a juror.
- 1805 & 1807 - Lincoln Co. KY Tax Lists show Frostin Snow and Leonard Snow ("son of Frostin Snow") and families living along the Green River. They probably moved there about 1805.

Isaac & William Snow (1778 to about 1788)

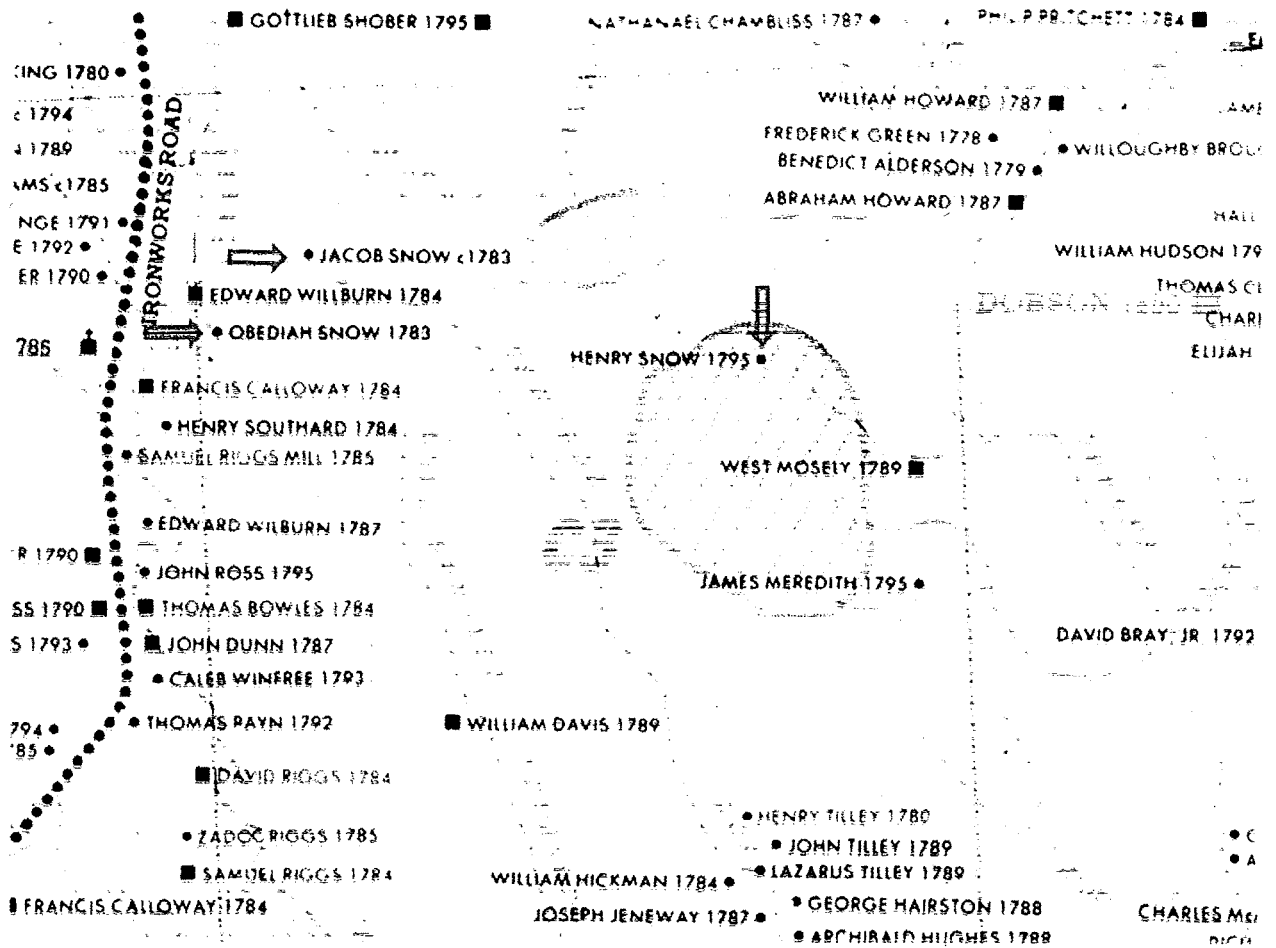
- 1778 - Isaac Snow and wife, Martha, and children/grandchildren Ebenezer, Isaac, Joseph, Benjamin, John, and William move from Kent County, DE to Surry County, NC. William purchases 250 acres on Fifth Creek in Rowan County, NC (later Surry Co., and later Forsyth Co.) The 1780 Kent County, DE Tax List has the notation "Gon to Karoliner" next to William's name.
- 1782 – 85 - Surry County Tax Lists for Capt. Cook's district (now in Forsyth County) show William Snow with 250 acres and 1 white poll; Ebenezer Snow with 0 acres and 1 white poll; and John Snow with 250 acres and 1 white poll. The 1785 Surry Co. Tax List shows Ebenezer with 200 acres.
- 1783 - Surry County, NC Marriage Bond filed for Ebenezer Snow and Sally Wicker.
- 1788 - Both Isaac and Ebenezer Snow petition the N.C. State Legislature for the formation of Randolph County. They have moved to today's Randolph Co., NC. 1790 Federal Census for Randolph Co., NC shows Isaac, Ebenezer, and Martha Snow.
- 1790 and 1800 Federal Census - Rowan Co., NC (now Davie Co.) shows William Snow and family. William and family moved from today's Forsyth Co., NC prior to 1790.
- 1806 - Warren County, TN (today DeKalb Co.) Tax List shows Ebenezer, John, Isaac, Joseph, Benjamin, and William Snow have all moved to Warren County, TN.

Henry Snow (c. 1730 – 1810)

Married: To Be Determined

Shown in Surry Co., NC – 1771 to 1794

- 1765 - Henry Snow is paid a bounty for a "wolf's head" in Rowan Co., NC (now Surry Co.)
- 1768 - 75 - Surry County, NC Tax List shows Henry Snow with 1 white poll.
- 1778 - Henry Snow enters 300 acres of land along the Mitchell River in Surry Co.
- 1779 - Surry County land entry is located in the fork of "Henry Snow's Mill Creek."
- 1782 - Surry County Tax List shows Henry Snow and Jacob Snow (single) on Capt. Sheppard's List. Jacob is at least 16 years old.
- 1784 & 1785 - Wilkes County (now Surry Co.) Tax List shows Henry Snow as 1 white poll and 250 acres. Jacob Snow and Moses Snow each have 1 white poll. They are all over 21 years old.
- 1785 - Wilkes Co. (now Surry Co.) Court Records show Henry Snow maintaining a road from the Mitchell River to the Virginia line.
- 1787 - Wilkes Co. (now Surry Co.) - Obediah Snow enters 100 acres of land along the Mitchell River.
- 1787 – 1790 - Wilkes Co. (now Surry Co.) Court Records show Moses Snow is a Constable in Capt. Hardin's District.
- 1787 - Wilkes Co., NC (now Surry Co.) Tax List for Capt. Hardin's District shows Henry Snow as 1 white poll and 250 acres; Jacob Snow as one white poll and 300 acres; Obediah Snow as no white poll (so under age 21) and 100 acres; and Moses Snow as one white poll and no acres.
- 1790 - Federal Census, Wilkes Co., NC (now Surry Co.) shows Henry Snow, 1 white male (wm) 16+ years; 5 white females (wf) 16+ years; and 4 wf under 16 (10 persons total); Jacob Snow, 1 wm 16+; 3 wm under 16; 3 wf 16+ (7 persons total); Obediah Snow, 1 wm 16+, 1 wm under 16; 2 wf 16+ (4 persons total); and William Snow, 1 wm 16+, 1 wf 16+ (2 persons total)

- 1791 - Wilkes Co., NC (now Surry Co.) Land Records show Henry Snow obtains grants of 100 acres and 150 acres along the Mitchell River.
- 1794 and thereafter - Surry Co., NC Tax List omits Henry and Moses Snow.
- 1800 - Surry County Land Records show that Henry Snow of Spartanburg, SC sold 150 acres along the Mitchell River to William Kanady. Henry and Moses moved to South Carolina about 1794 or thereafter. Henry dies in SC in 1810. After 1800, William Snow disappears from Surry Co. records and Jacob Snow disappears after 1805.

Obediah Snow (c. 1767-1823)

Married Abigail Riggs c. 1787

Born VA. In Surry Co. c. 1771

Died in Surry Co., NC

- 1771 - Obediah is one of Henry Snow's children who was born in Virginia, but moved with his father as a child to Surry County.
- 1787 - Wilkes Co., NC (now Surry Co.) Tax List shows Obediah with 100 acres, but no white poll; indicating that he is not yet 21 years old.
- Between 1787 and 1790 - Obediah married Abigail Riggs (1766-1821), daughter of his neighbor, Samuel Riggs. No marriage bond has been found. In his will, (probated Surry Co., NC – 1800) Samuel Riggs names his daughter, Abigail Snow.
- 1790 Federal Census, Surry Co., NC shows Obediah, his wife, a son under 16 years, and another female (not daughter) 16+ years living with them.
- 1790 – 93 - Surry Co., NC Tax List shows Obediah with 1 white poll and 100 acres.
- 1794 - Surry Co. Court Records appoint a jury, including Obediah Snow, to view and lay off a road crossing the Mitchell River along the south fork.
- 1794-95 - Surry Co. Tax List shows Obediah with 1 white poll and 740 acres. (He has purchased a 640 acre grant in addition to his original 100 acres.)

- 1798 - Surry County Court Records appoint Obediah overseer of the new marked road that goes by his house. He is replaced by another man in 1804.
- 1797-1800 - Surry Co., NC Tax List shows Obediah with 1 white poll, 500 acres.
- 1800 Federal Census, Surry County, NC shows Obediah Snow with 1 white male (wm) 26-45 years; 3 wm under 10 yrs.; 1 white female (wf) 26-45 yrs.; 1 wf 10-16 yrs.; 3 wf under 10 yrs.
- 1808-12 - Surry Co., NC Court Records often mention Obediah Snow as a member of juries and as part of groups to layoff a road.
- 1810 Federal Census, Surry Co., NC does not enumerate Obediah Snow. He has not moved and shows up again in 1820 Federal Census.
- 1812 – 1818 - Surry Co., NC Tax List shows Obediah with 1 white poll and 300 acres in 1812. 1813 & 1815 Tax List shows Obediah with 1 white poll, 1 black poll, and 100 acres. 1816 Tax List shows Obediah with 1 white poll, 1 black poll, and 200 acres. 1817 – 1818 Tax List shows him with 300 acres. 1819 – 1822 Tax List shows him with 450 acres.
- 1823 – Surry Co., NC Court Records show William Thompson, Obediah's neighbor, as the administrator of the estate of Obediah Snow and Guardian of his two minor children, Obediah L. and Jane. William buys Obediah's land/estate in 1825.

Children of Obediah Snow and Abigail Riggs (1766-1821):

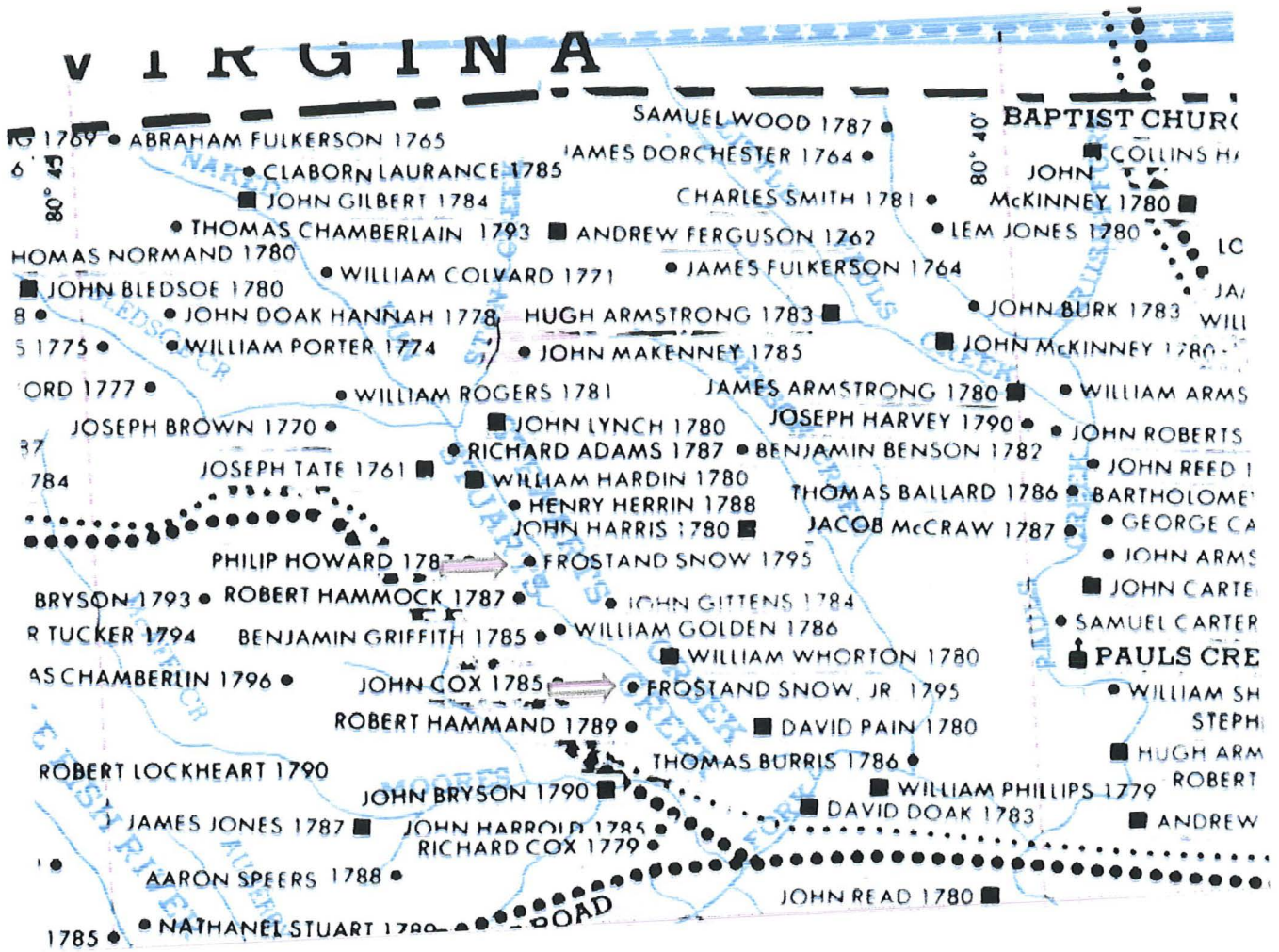

- Tabitha Snow (1787 – 18xx)
 - Married unknown. Died in Grayson Co., VA.
- **Larkin Snow (1789 – c. 1879)**
 - **Married Elizabeth Norman in Surry County, NC. 1810 Federal Census, Surry Co. NC shows Larkin and Elizabeth, both about 21 yrs. old, and daughter, Nancy, age 5. Was a miller. Died in Surry County, NC.**

- Levi Snow (1792 – 1869)
 - Married Abigail Bodine in Bedford Co., TN in 1819. Died in Kaufman, TX.
- **Mourning Snow (c. 1794 – 1883) Southard**
 - **Married her neighbor, Job Southard, in 1813 in Surry Co., NC. Lived and died in Surry Co., NC. Was a midwife and a fine weaver. Drew a widow's pension from the War of 1812. Buried in the Zephyr Community of Surry Co., NC.**
- Henry Snow (1799 – after 1850)
 - Married Rebecca ???? c. 1819. Moved to TN and had one child born there. Later moved to Macoupin Co., IL where he married Lourener Davis in 1834. Lived and died in IL.
- **Margaret “Peggy” Snow (c. 1800 – 1874) Willey**
 - **Married Christley Willey in Surry Co., NC in 1821. Lived and Died in Zephyr Community of Surry Co., NC. Buried in the Willey Cemetery in Elkin, Surry Co., NC.**
- Judah (Judith) Snow (1804 – 18xx)
 - May have married Meredith Phillips in Wilkes Co., NC in 1825. Otherwise, unknown.
- Obediah Lyon Snow (1809 – 1859)
 - After the death of his father in 1823, Obediah L. and his sister, Jane, were placed under the guardianship of his neighbor, William Thompson. Obediah moved to IL to be with his brother Henry and family. Served in the Black Hawk War in IL in 1832. Married Hannah Pitman in 1833 in Macoupin Co., IL. Lived and died in IL.
- Jane Snow (c. 1811 – c.1880)
 - Married William Wright Holder (1801 – c. 1880) in Dec. 1832 in Surry Co., NC. Moved to Graham Co., NC and died there after 1880.

Frost & Snow, Sr. (c. 1730-1813)

Married Elizabeth Johnson c. 1755

Lived in Albemarle/Bedford Co., VA

Moved to Surry Co. NC in 1787. Died in Surry Co., NC

- 1764 – Albemarle Co., VA – The vestry of Fredericksville parish processioned (verified the boundaries) the land of John Snow in his presence and that of his sons Frost_& and Ice_&.
- 1770 – Albemarle Co., VA property deed was recorded for the sale of 400 acres of land owned by John Johnson, deceased, and his wife, Elinor (Davis) Johnson. Proceeds conveyed to Elinor and her three daughters, which included “Frost_& Snow and his wife, Elizabeth.”
- 1782 & 1785 – Albemarle Co., VA Tax List shows Frost_& Snow with 12 in his household with 1 dwelling and 3 other buildings.
- 1786 – Albemarle Co., VA sale of 343 acres by Frost_& and Elizabeth Snow to his brother-in-law Ephraim Simmons (Seamonds), Jr.
- 1786 – Surry Co., NC Tax List of Capt. Willis shows Frost_& Snow with 400 acres.
- 1787 – Surry Co., NC sale by John Bledsoe of 300 acres on Ellets Branch, Stewarts Creek to Frost_& Snow for 182 pounds and 10 shillings of Virginia currency.
- 1787 – Albemarle Co., VA Tax List entry that Frost_& Snow moved to Surry Co., NC
- 1789 – Surry Co., NC Court Records show Frost_& Snow is appointed a road overseer.
- 1789 - 1793 – Surry Co., NC Tax List (Humphries District) shows Frost_& Snow, Sr. with no white poll (max age 50), 4 black polls, and 300 to 400 acres.
- 1790 Federal Census - Surry Co., NC shows Frost_& Snow, Sr. with 3 white males (wm) 16+ yrs., 3 wm under 16 yrs., 6 white females (wf), 10 slaves.
- 1792 – 1802 – Surry Co., NC Court Records show Frost_& Snow (Sr.) appointed juror.

- 1794 - 1800 – Surry Co., NC Tax List (Taliaferro) shows Frost_& Snow, Sr. with no white poll (max age 50), 5 black polls, and 400 to 500 acres.
- 1797 – Surry Co., NC Court Records show Frost_& Snow Sr. and Jr. among those appointed to lay out a new road from the Rockford Road to Flower Gap.
- 1800 Federal Census, Surry Co., NC shows Frost_& Snow, Sr. with 1 white male (wm) 45+, 1 wm 16-26, 2 wm under 10 yrs., 1 white female (wf) 45+, 1 wf 16-26, 2 wf under 10 yrs., and 8 slaves.
- 1802 – Surry County land sale of 100 acres on the south side of Ellets Branch, Stewarts Creek to Frost_& Snow (Sr.) for 75 pounds by Michael Ahart, Patrick Co., VA.
- 1810 Federal Census, Surry Co., NC shows Frost_& Snow (Sr.) with 1 wm 10-15, 2 wm 16-25, 1 wm 45+, 3 wf under 10 yrs., 1 wf 26-44, 1 wf 45+, and 10 slaves.
- 1811 – Surry Co., NC Court Records show Frost_& Snow, Sr. appointed to a committee to allot one year's support to Hannah McGeay, widow.
- 1813 – Surry Co., NC Court Records show that the estate of Frost_& Snow, Sr. was transferred to Charles Taliaferro as Executor. A writ of Lunacy is issued to the Sherriff to inquire into the mind of Elizabeth Snow, widow of Frost_& Snow, Sr. Taliaferro was also appointed Guardian of Elizabeth Snow, widow, who is a lunatic. A committee was appointed to lay out one year's provision for her.
- 1816 – Surry Co., NC Court Records show that the committee appointed to settle the estate of Frost_& Snow, Sr. made their report.
- Note: Charles Taliaferro will remain as the compensated Guardian of Elizabeth Snow, lunatic, for many years.

**Children of Frost_& Snow, Sr. and Elizabeth Johnson
Snow:**

Note: **BOLD** means lived & died in Surry Co., NC

- **Frost_ & Snow, Jr. (c. 1756 – 1852)**
 - **Married Elizabeth “Betsy” Ballard (c. 1761 – before 1852). Moved with his father from Albemarle Co., VA to Surry Co., NC about 1787. Lived and died in Surry Co., NC with extensive family.**
- Jane (Jenny) Snow (c. 1760 – c. 1849) Cave
 - Married Bartlett Cave in Dec. 1796 in Orange Co., VA. They lived in Orange Co., VA until at least 1809, when they moved to join her family in Surry Co., NC. Household is shown in the 1820 Federal Census for Surry Co., NC. Between 1833 – 1835, they moved to Lone Jack, Jackson Co., MO.
- **Frances Snow (c. 1763 – c. 1845) Cave**
 - **Married John Cave, brother of Bartlett Cave (her brother in law), about 1789 in Orange Co., VA. They lived in Orange Co., VA and moved with Bartlett and Jenny Cave to Surry Co., NC. John Cave died after 1840 and Frances Cave about 1845, both in Surry Co., NC. Many of their children migrated to Jackson Co., MO.**
- Richard Snow (c. 1766 – c. 1842)
 - Married ???? Hale in Virginia and died before 1842 in Carroll Co., VA.
- Thomas Snow (c. 1770 – 1818)
 - Married Elizabeth Hale Burris and moved to TN. Drowned in the Clinch River, Roane Co., TN.
- **Johnson Snow (c. 1772 – c. 1855)**

- **Born in Albemarle Co., VA and may have lived in VA until he appears in Surry Co., NC in 1830 Federal Census with his family. In 1850 Federal Census for Surry Co., NC, he gives his age as 78 and born in VA. He is much confused in family genealogies with his nephew, John Snow, son of Frost_ & Snow, Jr. Johnson lived near Ice Snow and Richard Snow in Surry Co., NC – relationship not established.**
- Anne (Adrianna) Snow (c. 1772 – 1824) Taliaferro
 - Married Benjamin Taliaferro in June 1791 in Surry Co., NC. Moved to Georgia and later TN. Died in Bedford Co., TN. Rumored, but unproven, that Anne and her brother, Johnson, were twins.
- **Nancy Snow (c. 1780 – 1855) Beamer**
 - **Married Henry Beamer (c. 1780 – c. 1836) between 1800 – 1804 in Surry Co., NC. Henry was from Grayson Co., VA and first paid taxes there in 1799. They lived in Grayson Co., VA until 1812, when they moved to Surry Co., NC. Had 10+ children. In the 1840 Federal Census, Surry Co., NC, Nancy, age 60, is living with her son, Henry Beamer(Jr.), age 32, along with her son, Andrew, age 20.**
- Ice_ & Snow (1781 – 1860)
 - Married Mary Haynes (1791 – 1864). Died in Clinton Co., OH.
- Hail_ & (Hayland) Snow (c. 1782 – 1885)
 - Married Susan Thompson in 1820. Died in Carroll Co., VA.

Frost & Snow, Jr. (1756-1852)

Married Elizabeth Ballard 1783

Lived in Albemarle/Bedford Co., VA

Moved to Surry County in 1787. Died in Surry Co., NC

- 1781 – Orange Co., VA Militia Petition was signed by Frost_& Snow (Jr.) [Note: Who was literate as opposed to Frost_&, Sr., who was not] regarding a request to repeal an act of compelled service for the militia. The petition was rejected on March 14, 1781. On Nov. 15, 1837, Frost_& Snow, Jr. applied for a Revolutionary War pension in Surry Co., NC, stating that he had served in the Orange Co., VA Militia.
- 1783 – Albemarle Co., VA Marriage Bond for Frost_& Snow, Jr.'s marriage to Elizabeth Ballard, daughter of Thomas Ballard. The Albemarle Co., VA Tax List for 1783 shows Frost_& Snow, Jr. with one male and one female in the household.
- 1784 – Orange Co., VA Court Records accept the claim of Frost_& Snow, Jr. for 27 days of service driving cattle "for public use" during the Revolutionary War.
- 1789 – Surry Co., NC land sale by Joseph Porter and wife, Rose, of 100 acres on Moores Fork, Stewarts Creek to Frost_& Snow (Jr.) for 30 pounds NC currency.
- 1789 - 1793 – Surry Co., NC Tax List (Humphries District) shows Frost_& Snow, Jr. with 1 white poll (21+ years) and 100 acres.
- 1790 Federal Census - Surry Co., NC shows Frost_& Snow, Jr. with 1 wm 16+ yrs., 3 wm under 16 yrs., 1 wf.
- 1794 - 1800 – Surry Co., Tax List (Humphries, later Taliaferro) shows Frost_& Snow, Jr. shown with 1 white poll (21+ years) and 100 to 150 acres.
- 1797 – Surry Co., NC Court Records show Frost_& Snow Sr. and Jr. among those appointed to lay out a new road from the Rockford Road to Flower Gap.
- 1800 – Surry Co., NC Court Records show Frost_& Snow Sr. and Jr. among those appointed to lay out a new road from John Horn's to the Flour Gap Road.

- 1800 Federal Census, Surry Co., NC shows Frost_& Snow, Jr. with 1 wm 26-45, 3 wm 10-16, 2 wm under 10 yrs., 1 wf 26-46, 1 wf 16-26, 1 wf under 10 yrs.
- 1804 & 1805 – Surry Co., NC Court Records show Frost_& Snow Jr. among those appointed to lay out a new road from David Davis's to the Good Spur.
- 1805 – Albemarle Co., VA Court Records for the estate settlement of Thomas Ballard list three slaves, named Lucy, Rebecca, and Andersen, and 14+ pounds currency given to Frost_& Snow, Jr. Thomas Ballard was his father-in-law.
- 1810 Federal Census, Surry Co., NC shows Frost_& Jr. with 2 wm under 10 yrs., 1 wm 10-15, 3 wm 16-25, 1 wm 45+, 1 wf under 10 yrs., 1 wf 10-15, 1 wf 45+, and 6 slaves.
- 1812 – 1815 - Surry Co., Tax List (now Underwoods District) shows Frost_& Snow, Jr. with 1 to 2 white poll (21+ years) and 150 acres.
- 1816 – 1818 - Surry Co., Tax List (Underwood) shows Frost_& Snow Jr. with 0 white polls (born before 1764), 2 or 3 black polls, and 150 acres.
- 1819 - Surry Co., Tax List (Underwood) shows Frost_& Snow Jr. with 0 white polls (born before 1764), 3 black polls, and 250 acres.
- 1821 - 1822 - Surry Co., Tax List (Easley, previous Underwood) shows Frost_& Snow Jr. with 0 white polls (born before 1764), 4 black polls, and 328 acres. He is noted as adjacent to his brother-in-law, Henry Beamer, on Moores Fork, Stewarts Creek.
- 1839 – Surry Co., NC Court Records contain the will filed by Frost_& Snow, Jr. in which he leaves slaves, Lucy Ann and Anderson, to his wife. A Feb. 1852 codicil to the will stipulates that at his death, Lucy was not to be sold to anyone who would separate her from her “companions.”
- 1852 – Surry Co., NC Court Records show will of Frost_& Snow, Jr. probated in May 1852.

**Children of Frost_ & Snow, Jr. & Elizabeth Ballard
(c.1765 – c.1840):**

Note: **BOLD** means lived & died in Surry Co., NC

- **William Snow (c. 1784 – 1861)**
 - **Born in Albemarle Co., VA, he appears to have married three times in Surry Co., NC: Sarah Tucker – 1808; Rebecca Masters – 1818; and Sarah Christian – 1827. Buried in Robert P. White farm cemetery, located along Kings' Creek, south of Dobson, Surry Co., NC (location not verified).**
- **Thomas Snow (c. 1787 – 1843)**
 - **Born in Albemarle Co., VA, moved to Surry Co., NC as a child. Veteran of the War of 1812, serving in Capt. Witcher's Surry Volunteers. Married Elizabeth "Betsy" Wilmoth (1789 – c. 1845) in Jan. 1812 in Surry Co., NC. Had 9 children. Lived / died Surry Co., NC.**
- John Snow (1790-1851)
 - Married Frances Easley and moved to Lone Jack, Jackson Co., MO in the 1830s along with his aunt/uncle Bartlett & Jane Snow Cave, some of the children of John & Frances Snow Cave, and John Snow's next youngest brother, James. Buried in Lone Jack cemetery.
- James Snow (c. 1793 – 1872)
 - Married his first cousin, Allie Elizabeth Cave (c. 1805 – after 1880), daughter of Bartlett and Jane Snow Cave. Moved with his in-laws to Lone Jack, Jackson Co., MO and is buried there in Lone Jack cemetery.
- Elizabeth "Betsy" Snow (before 1798 – c. 1856)

- Married Stephen Wilmoth (1793 – 1861) in Surry Co., NC. They lived in Surry Co., NC until 1843, when Stephen sold 300 acres of land to Lewis Atkins in Dobson Township. The family then moved to Wythe Co. or Carroll Co., VA.
- **Richard “Dick” Snow (1801 – 1871)**
 - **Married Sarah “Sally” Tucker (1798 – 1879). Lived / died in Surry Co., NC. Dick and Sally originally were buried at the family graveyard on his farm. Graveyard was in the path of I-77 when built. Graveyard inhabitants were moved to near-by Round Peak Primitive Baptist Church where they were members.**

- 1785 – Orange Co., VA Tax List shows Fielding as a free male 21+, with 3 horses and 10 cattle, in the household of his father, Thomas Snow.
- 1789 – Albemarle Co., VA - Fielding has moved to Albemarle Co., VA, where he signs a petition for the establishment of a tobacco inspection station. The 1789 Albemarle Co., VA Tax List shows Fielding owning 1 horse and no land.
- 1790 Federal Census – Albemarle Co., VA shows Fielding in Fredericksville Parish.
- 1792 – Albemarle Co., VA Court Records show Fielding as one of the men ordered to help maintain the Court House Road from Mitchie's Ford to Shifflett's.
- January 1793 – Albemarle Co., VA Marriage Bond shows Fielding marries Sarah Foster, daughter of Henry & Elizabeth Foster. They move thereafter to Surry Co., NC.
- 1794 - Surry Co., NC Tax Lists show Fielding with 50 acres of land near his uncle, Frost & Snow, Sr. and cousin, Frost & Snow, Jr.
- 1796 - Surry Co., NC Tax Lists show Fielding has moved along the Mitchell River and owns 130 acres next door to his cousin, Obediah Snow. Fielding would live close by his cousin Obediah for the remainder of their lives. [Obediah dies 1823 / Fielding 1824]
- 1798 – 1800 - Surry County, NC Court Records appoint juries, including Fielding, with a view to road improvements.
- 1800 Federal Census, Surry Co., NC shows Fielding's household with 1 white male (wm) 26-45 yrs.; 3 wm under 10 yrs.; 1 white female (wf) 26-45 yrs.; 1 wf under 10 yrs. 1800 Surry Co., NC Tax Lists shows Fielding with 150 acres and 2 white polls.
- 1801 - Surry Co. NC Court Records, show Fielding bought 97 ½ acres on the Flat Branch of Fishes River at a public sale / sheriff's auction in late 1800.

- 1802 - Surry Co., NC Court Records grant Fielding an exemption in the future of the poll tax for his negro girl, "Sillar."
- 1802 – 1811 – Surry Co., NC Court Records appoint Fielding a "Patroller" in Wilcher's District.
- 1803 – Surry Co., NC Tax and Court Records show Fielding sold his 75 acres on the south fork of Mitchell's River and buys at public auction 149 acres on the Flat Branch of Fishes River (see previous purchase at that site in 1800).
- 1810 Federal Census, Surry Co., NC shows Fielding with 3 white males (wm) under 10 yrs., 2 wm 10-15, 1 wm 16-25, 1 wm 26-44, 2 white females (wf) under 10 yrs., 1 wf 10-15, 1 wf 26-44, and 2 slaves.
- 1812 – 1815 - Surry Co., NC Tax List (Wilcher's District / formerly Ogleby's) shows Fielding with 220 acres and 1 white poll and 1 black poll along the Mitchell River, valued at \$600.
- 1816 – Surry Co., NC Court Records appoint Fielding's oldest son, Ruel, a "Patroller" in Capt. Potter's District (same as Wilcher's District earlier).
- 1816 -1822 - Surry Co., NC Tax List shows Fielding Snow as having no white poll (born 1765 or before) and 1 black poll with 220 acres on More's Fork (1816-1821), valued at \$550. In 1822, he is shown with 270 acres.
- 1818 – Surry Co., NC Marriage Bond shows Ruel Snow marries Chloe Wilmoth.
- 1819 - 1820 - Surry Co., NC Tax List shows Fielding's sons, Ruel, with 100 acres and 1 white poll and, "Simon" (actually Simpson), with 400 acres and 1 white poll.
- In 1822, Fielding won a lawsuit in the Surry County Court with the jury "finding all issues in favour of the plaintiff."
- 1824 – Surry Co., NC Court Records probate Fielding Snow's will written Oct. 24, 1824. He leaves his estate to his wife "Sary" during her natural life and, at her death, divides his estate equally among his sons and daughters, except for his daughter, Lucinda Wilmoth, who is deceased and whose share is given to her son, Tyson Wilmoth. Sarah would live until 1852, in her latter years with her son, Fielding Snow, Jr.

- (1) John Snow and his family, including his married daughter Matilda F. (Snow) Golding, migrated with other familys from Surry County, NC, to the western area of Missouri, in 1837. They settled in Jackson, Cass, and Lafayette counties. He helped to lay-off the small crossroads community of Lone Jack in VanBuren Township of Jackson County, and donated land for the community cemetery. He was a farmer and a Justice of the Peace. His cabin was given the name "Cottonwood," and in the magazine Pioneer Times [volume 9, number 2, April 1985 issue, page 135] is a reproduced article on and photograph of this cabin. Originally published in 1921 it indicates that Stephen I. Snow had recently died and one of John Snow's daughters--not identified--married a Union sympathizer. "Cottonwood" was the first home in Lone Jack to have a board floor. The floor was laid by John Taliaferro Franklin with the help of a slave, and the boards were whip-sawed and then fastened to the sills of the cabin with wooden pegs. The boards were then planed smooth. In 1920 the cabin was owned by Mrs. Julia F. Shawhan. [See History of Jackson County, Missouri, by W. Z. Hickman, c. 1920, Historical Publishing Company, Topeka, KS, pg. 322.] John Snow wrote his will 13 November 1848 and it was probated in Jackson County, MO, 19 July 1851. He died of cholera.

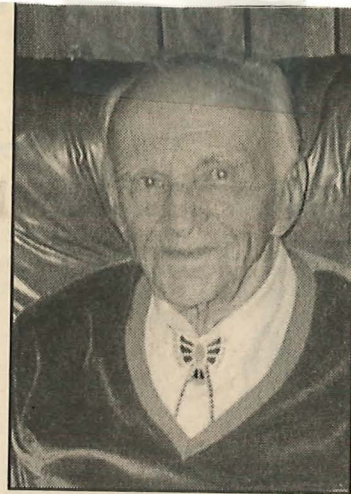

Don Culler, a Founder Of Gardner Mirror, Dies

Don T. Culler, a Wilkesboro native who helped build Gardner Mirror Corp. into one of the nation's largest mirror manufacturers, died yesterday after a long illness. He was 65.

Culler, who was the president and chief executive officer of the corporation, started Gardner Mirror with his father-in-law, Edd F. Gardner in 1961. Culler became president about 1971.

Everette H. Mayes, Gardner's director of purchasing, said that Culler had a good relationship with his employees. "He was more like a co-worker than a boss. He really loved the people who worked for him and wanted them to succeed."

Ralph Langley, Gardner's plant manager, said that Culler had equal regard for all the company's customers, "whether it was the furniture industry or people looking to put a mirror in their hall."

Culler attended Wilkesboro High School and was in the Army Air Corps during World War II. In 1948, he joined Carolina Mirror Co., which Edd Gardner founded in 1937. He was the vice president

when he and Gardner left and started Gardner Mirror Corp. in 1961.

Culler was active in business and civic affairs in Wilkes County. He was a director of the Northwestern Bank and the Wilkes Chamber of Commerce and was president of the North Wilkesboro Lions Club.

Culler was a trustee at First United Methodist Church in North Wilkesboro and was very active on behalf of The Children's Home in Winston-Salem. He was on the home's board of trustees and led the annual drive to raise money from Methodist churches in the North Wilkesboro district.

Mayes, who attended First United Methodist Church with Culler, said that Culler made up of the church's budget deficit out of his own pocket two years ago.

Culler is survived by his wife, Mary Lee, and two daughters, Donna and Patricia.

Another one of the very old women in Van Buren township is dead. Mrs. Frances Snow Smith who was born in North Carolina December 4, 1832, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Joe Spainhour near Lone Jack January 3, 1908. She had been confined to her bed for three months before death relieved her of her suffering.

When only 4 years old she came to Missouri with her parents who settled in Van Buren township. At the age of 18 years she united with Lone Jack Baptist Church and always lived an upright life, being a good neighbor and an earnest worker in her Master's vineyard. On November 24, 1854 she was married to Thomas G. Smith. To this union 8 children were born, four of whom are yet living, viz: Frank Smith, Mrs Wm Rolls, Mrs. Joe Spainhour and Mrs. Milton Clements. The funeral was conducted by Rev. W.T. Church, pastor of the Lone Jack Baptist Church.
