Worked on your John Moncrief this morning - without any great success. Went first to the land grant office hoping to come up with a crown grant. Checked out all five of the earliest counties. -0- Nothing. Tried for all possible spellings - Don't think that you need to be told of the dozens of those.

Picked up a copy of the will from the Secr'y of State wills in the Archives. They did a wonderful job of coping and darkening the xerox so that we can read it fairly easily. If you don't understand the old script, send it back to me and I will write it out for you.

Note that he leaves 160 acres to each of his four sons. 640 acres in all. Went into the county records and find that the deeds don't start until about 1751. (or 1741) Showing on the cross-index for Cutrituck Co. are deeds for Josiah Mumcrief
