ROLL EXPLANATION.

THE "Roll" on each double page is intended to embrace a period of six months, five Sundays being allowed for each, to meet all requirements. Only one form of Roll is adopted for officers, teachers, and scholars; and the blanks at the top of the page are to be filled out so as to read, "Roll of Officers," "Roll of Teachers," "Roll of Infant Class," "Roll of Bible Class," "Roll of Class No. 1," "No. 2," and so on.

In Class Rolls, place the names of the teacher at the head of the list, between the second and third red lines, but do not include teacher in the addition to ascertain the number present, as this is done in the Roll of Teachers.

The percentage of attendance for each Sabbath, or for the month or quarter, may be easily obtained by adding the lines "Present" and "On Roll," and dividing the former by the later. This may be made an interesting feature of the school by having one or two banners to be placed over the two classes showing the best percentage of attendance.



SUMMARY EXPLANATION.

LIKE the "Roll," the "Summary" is ruled to allow five Sundays for each month, but covering a period of only three months on each double page.

Extend from Sabbath to Sabbath the number "Present" and "On Roll," opposite the names of the classes in the left-hand margin, as in the form given. Add the columns "Present" and "On Roll," and place the aggregates in the proper blanks near the bottom of the page, so as to show the "Total Scholars" present and on roll. Fill the blanks for "Officers" and "Teachers" under "Total Scholars" with aggregates taken from Officers' and Teachers' Rolls. These three aggregates added together make up the "Grand Total."

The percentage of attendance of the entire school can be had as in the classes.

Scholars transferred from one class to another do not affect the general aggregate of scholars, but only increase or diminish the classes in which such changes occur. The same is true if an officer becomes a teacher or scholar, or a teacher an officer or scholar.

The correctness of the "Summary" should be tested every Sabbath, as follows: Take the highest, or last number on the "Register of Members," kept in a separate book which we have provided for the purpose, subtract the "Disposals," add the "Re-admitted," and the sum should be the same as the "Grand Total." To illustrate:

The highest "number" on the "Register" is, say, . . .	500
The highest "number" on the "Disposals" is, say, . . .	200
	—
Difference,	300
The highest "number" on the "Re-admitted" is, say, . . .	50
	—
Total,	350

If this does not agree with the "Grand Total," the error can be easily discovered by comparing in detail the "On Roll" columns of the current and previous sabbath.



THE above explanations refer to the "Complete Sunday-school Register," which has been provided for the purpose of preserving in permanent form the names and relation of all who have been in any manner connected with the school. Each book is complete in itself, but it is earnestly recommended that all permanent schools shall supply themselves with these Registers, which will last a generation and make up an interesting history of the school and of each member connected with it.
