These are from our census book rather than microfilm. We could not find Ephraim Nicholson in the 1840 book but found him in the 1830 book. Those copies are enclosed also, as well as Ephraim and Micajah Nicholson on the Surry 1850 census.

We did not find any mention of a Hannah Nicholson in our records. You state she was born in Wilkes Co. in 1828. Wilkes County formed from Surry County in 1777.

Surry County does have Will Abstract books from 1771-1901. We only found Micajah Nicholson (1870), Surry County Will Book 6:213. If you wish to get a copy of this will write the Department of Cultural Resources, Archives and Records Section, 109 E. Jones Street, Raleigh, NC 27601-2807.
