I was adopted at birth by Police Vice Detective James F. Gray and Thelma Mae Gray of Tampa, Florida upon my birth at the Lake Magdalene Home for Women in Tampa, Florida on September 11, 1939.**

**I knew my mother all my life as I was growing up, as a friend of the family, but never got to meet my father before he died. I found him and the Cameron family two years after his death. I did, however, through the Postmaster in Vass, meet my Uncle John Cameron's wife Mattie Cameron in Raeford before she died. I was also able to meet my half-brother Claude "Sonny" Cameron in Livermore, California and my half-sisters (Mary Blue Catlin) son when he performed in a ballet show in Selma, Alabama. I also met my half-sister Jane Cameron Williamson near Southern Pines.**

**I had two sons, James Franklin Arnie Gray (named after Grandfather Arnie McCraw of Mt. Airy) and Heath Charles Mason Gray (named after Lucille's husband Charles). James (Jay) had three daughters, Darian, Jayden and Alexander in Tampa, Florida and Heath (Mason) had one daughter, Taylor Cheyenne just north of Birmingham, Alabama.**

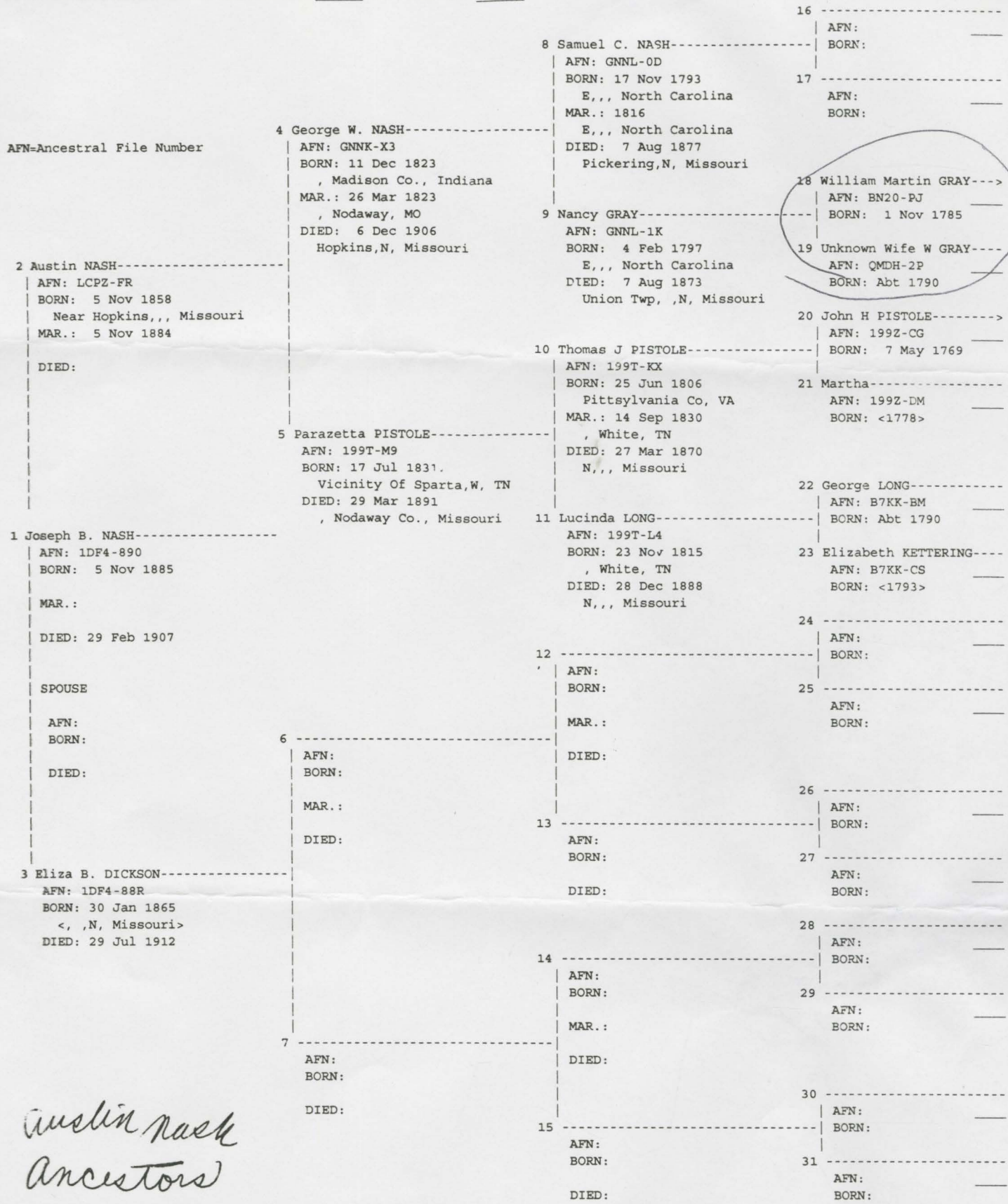

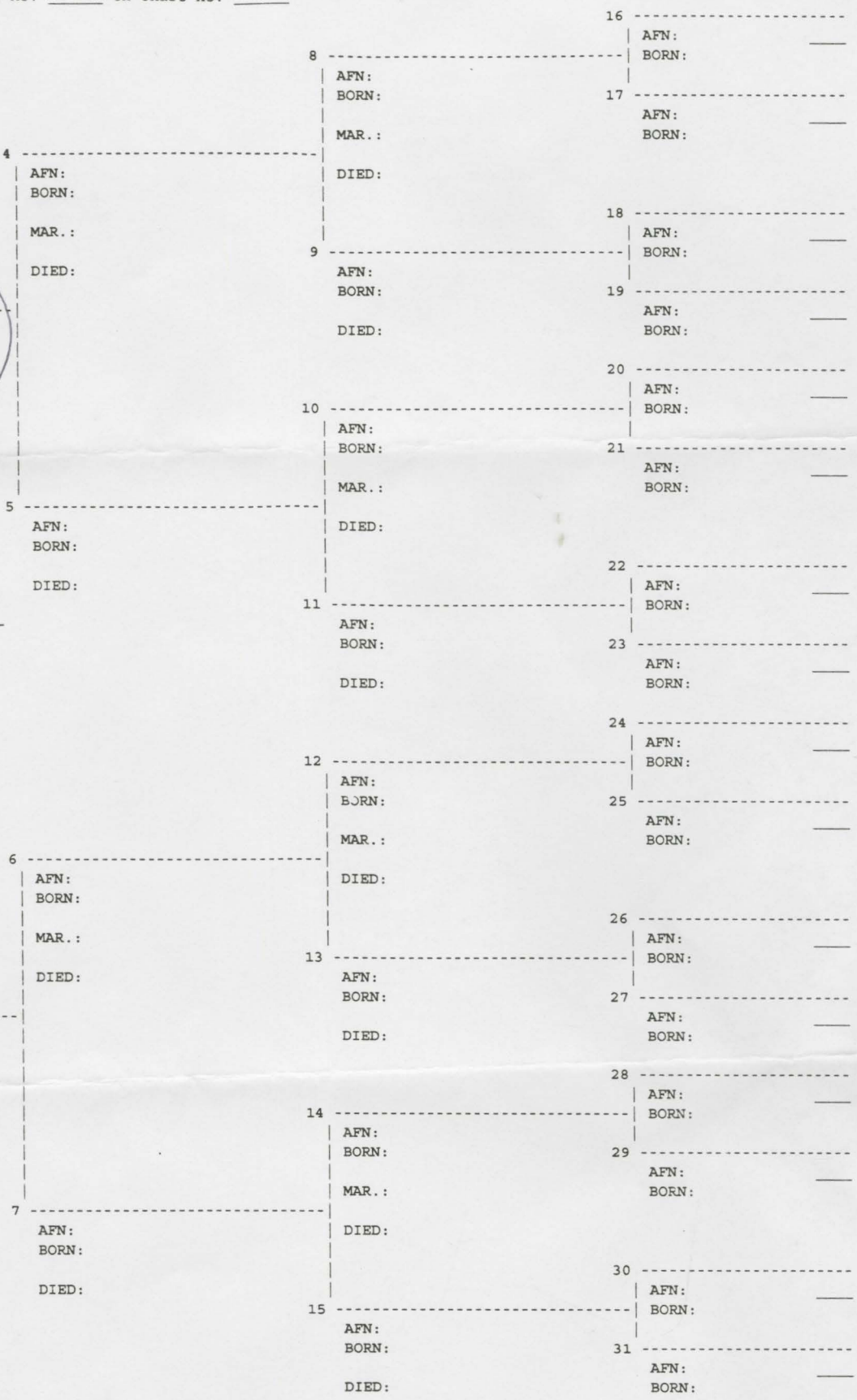

Thank you for your letter postmarked March 27, 2002 regarding your ancestors William Beavens Gray and William Martin Gray.

Some of the records in Surry County naturally only show William Gray so we have no way of knowing if this is your ancestor or not.

Apparently a William B. Gray married Mary Moorefield in Surry Co. as 8 April 1820 was the bond date. Perhaps he had married previously and this was a later wife. His will lists Mary as his wife in 1836.

He is listed as William B. Gray in the 1810 Surry County census so we know he was in Surry before he married Mary. In 1810 he already has at least three children in the household. His son William, age 16-26, was probably the other William listed in 1810. In 1820 his sons Annanias and Benjamin (ages 26-45) are head of household. In 1830 Surry County census Bevin Gray and wife are both age 70-80 years old, still head of household. Annanias Gray is in Surry Co. in 1830.

We have enclosed some information that was found in various records. You can send for a copy of the marriage bond record from the Surry County Register of Deeds, P. O. Box 303, Dobson, NC 27017 at 25 cents per copy plus postage, and a copy of the estate record and will from the Department of Cultural Resources, Archives and Records Section, 109 E. Jones Street, Raleigh, NC 27601-2807. They will advise you of the cost.

We hope this information has helped some with your research. If you wish to put a query in our quarterly journal, we will be happy to do so at no cost. Good luck with your research.


You were so very kind last Spring to help me with my Gentry and Phillips lines--your help was very much appreciated. I now have two more requests, if possible.

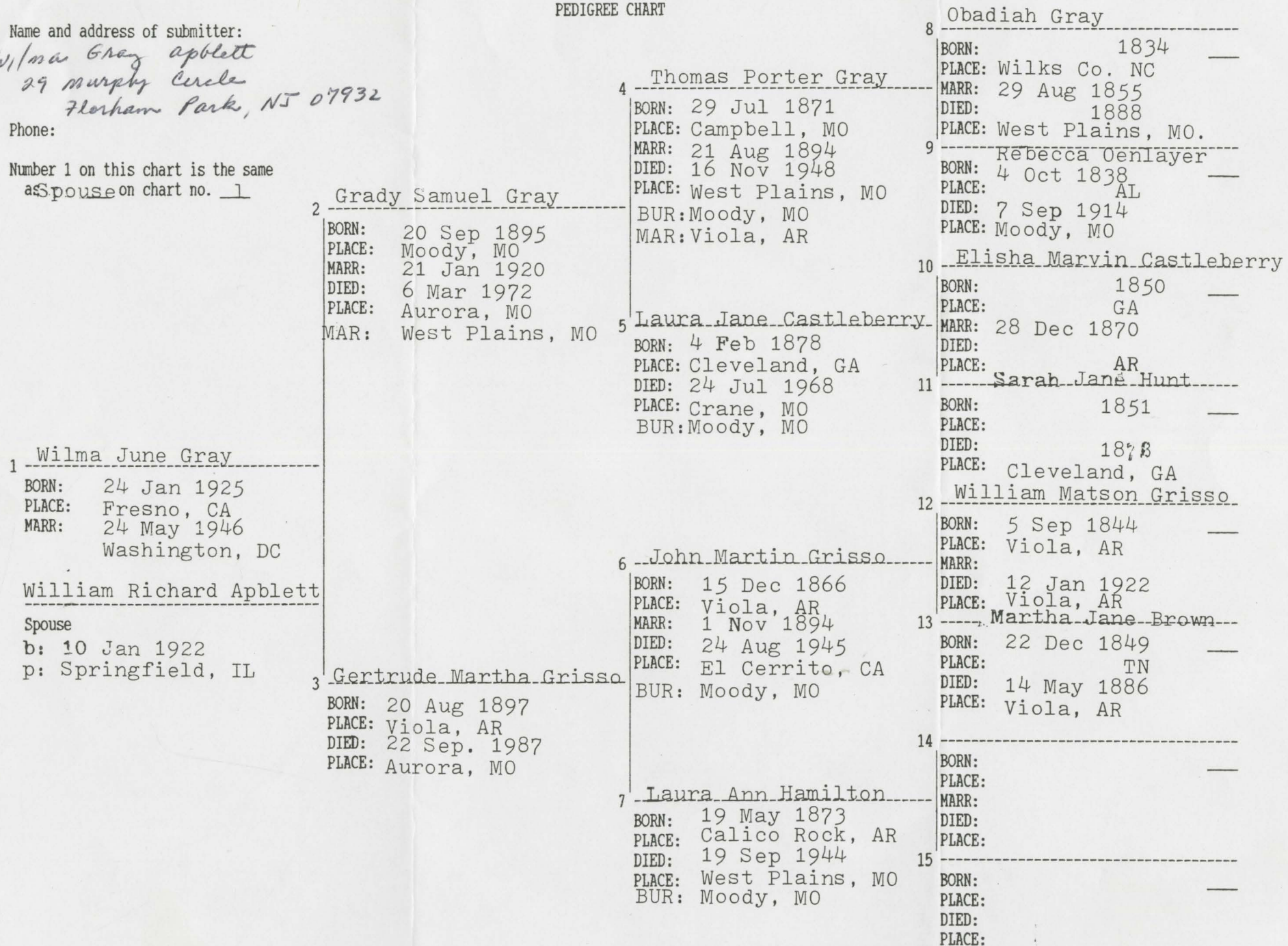

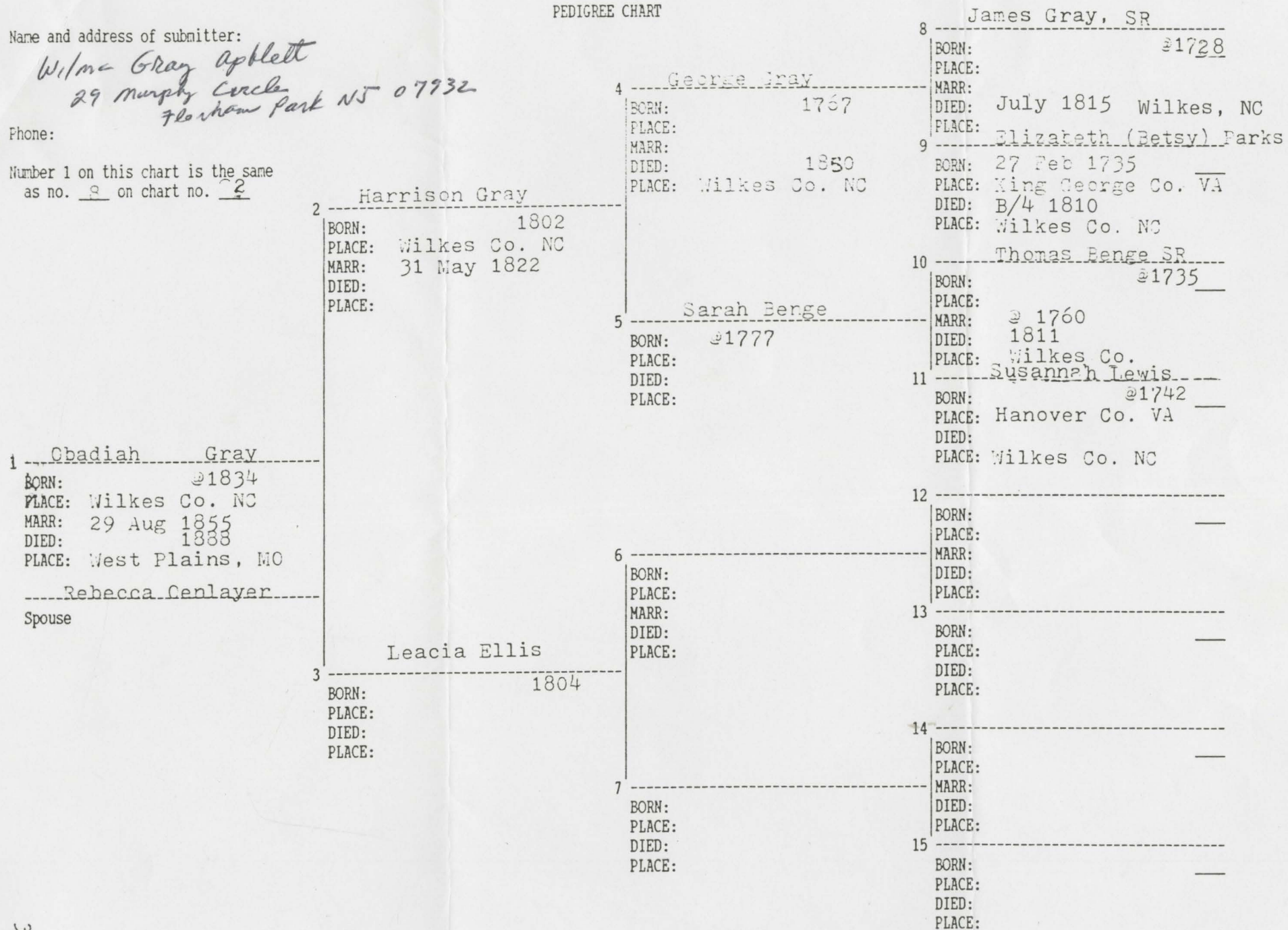

Thank you for your letter postmarked March 27, 2002 regarding your ancestors William Beavens Gray and William Martin Gray.

Some of the records in Surry County naturally only show William Gray so we have no way of knowing if this is your ancestor or not.

Apparently a William B. Gray married Mary Moorefield in Surry Co. as 8 April 1820 was the bond date. Perhaps he had married previously and this was a later wife. His will lists Mary as his wife in 1836.

He is listed as William B. Gray in the 1810 Surry County census so we know he was in Surry before he married Mary. In 1810 he already has at least three children in the household. His son William, age 16-26, was probably the other William listed in 1810. In 1820 his sons Annanias and Benjamin (ages 26-45) are head of household. In 1830 Surry County census Bevin Gray and wife are both age 70-80 years old, still head of household. Annanias Gray is in Surry Co. in 1830.

We have enclosed some information that was found in various records. You can send for a copy of the marriage bond record from the Surry County Register of Deeds, P. O. Box 303, Dobson, NC 27017 at 25 cents per copy plus postage, and a copy of the estate record and will from the Department of Cultural Resources, Archives and Records Section, 109 E. Jones Street, Raleigh, NC 27601-2807. They will advise you of the cost.

**GEORGE W. NASH,**

farmer and stock raiser, section 13, was born on the 11th of December, 1823, in Wayne County, Indiana. His father, Samuel C. Nash, a native of North Carolina, was a farmer and sailor. His mother, whose maiden name was Nancy Gray, was also born in North Carolina. George spent his youth upon a farm in Madison County, Indiana, attending the schools of those early times. In 1843, he came to Missouri, and on the 8th of July, 1843, located in Nodaway County, near the town of Xenia. In the fall of that year he cast his first ballot, voting the straight Whig ticket. At the age of twenty-one years he began life for himself, his capital consisting only of his willing hands and brave heart. That he made good use of this capital is shown by the position he occupies to-day. The early struggles of these pioneers can never be imagined by those who have never passed such an ordeal. The nearest trading point of Mr. Nash was at Savannah, Andrew County. He remembers an instance of himself and brother going to Andrew County to split rails in order to obtain corn to eat. A friend, William Ingalls, took the corn to mill, and from there home to the boy's parents. When they returned they found the corn had been eaten or loaned to the neighbors, and they were obliged to earn more. In 1846 a report came to the settlers that the Mormons and Indians were contemplating an attack upon them. The citizens hurried to the towns for protection, among these being Mrs. Nash—George's mother—who shouldered her musket and marched to the front, determined to die game. The enemies, however, failed to put in an appearance. In the spring of 1862 Mr. N. moved to Taylor County, Iowa, where he remained thirteen years. In the fall of 1864 he enlisted in Company C, Fourth Iowa Infantry, and marched through with Sherman to the sea, taking part in the grand review at Washington. He now owns 235 acres of land, with an orchard of 300 trees and fine residence. He is engaged in stock raising, having one thoroughbred and some graded cattle, but gives his attention principally to sheep interests. He has held the offices of road overseer and school director. Mr. Nash was married on March 26, 1846, to Miss P. Pistole, daughter of Thomas J. Pistole, Esq. They have seven children: Elvina (now Mrs. D. Boyer), born April 2, 1849; William T., born December 28, 1851; John H., born February 7, 1854; Austin L., born November 5, 1858; Timothy G., born February 23, 1863; Nora B., born August 18, 1866, and Alta, born August 6, 1871. Mr. N. belongs to Pickering Lodge, No. 472, A. F. and A. M. He is Democratic in politics, and belongs to the Christian Church.

WILLIAM M. PISTOLE.

A well remembered citizen of Union township who labored there not only for his own advancement and that of his immediate family, but who had at heart the general good of his neighbors and fellowmen was William Pistole, who is now sleeping the sleep of the just. He was a man of friendly and generous instincts, honest and trustworthy, therefore numbered his friends by the scores wherever he was known.

Mr. Pistole was born in Tennessee, March 11, 1833, and when ten years of age came to Buchanan county, Missouri, in the fall of 1842, and in the spring of the following year he came to Nodaway county, thus being among the early settlers here. He was the son of Thomas J. and Lucinda (Long) Pistole, the former born in Virginia, it is believed, for there his family lived in the early days. Mr. Pistole settled on the One Hundred and Two river, near the Narrows, two and one-half miles north of Pickering; the house he first lived in used to stand on the bluffs there. After a time he moved to the upland between the Mowry and Mazingo branch, three miles east of Pickering on the farm now owned by Edmund Harvey. They entered land from the government and there Thomas Pistole spent the balance of his life, dying on March 27, 1870, at an advanced age. He was a hard worker and a man well thought of. His widow survived until December 28, 1888, reaching the age of seventy-three years. Eleven children were born to them, namely: Parazetta married George W. Nash, both now deceased; Austin Nash, of Maryville, is their son; William M., of this review; George W. is living retired in Kansas City; John died in young manhood; Steven C. is living retired at Hopkins, this county; Leander B. died in middle life; Adeline

D. married George Alexander, now of Seattle, Washington; Nancy C. married James Craven and they are living in Union township, west of Pickering; James C. is a banker at Hopkins; Martha E. married Jacob Reed and she died when young in years.

William M. Pistole grew to maturity on the farm and remained at home until he married. He received a common school education in Buchanan county and he became a teacher in Nodaway. On December 28, 1854, he married Amanda C. Neal, daughter of Henry and Sally (Maddy) Neal. She was born in Gallia county, Ohio, December 3, 1834, and she came to Missouri in 1853. Her father settled about four miles northeast of Maryville, near where his son, John Neal, now lives, and there both parents spent the remainder of their lives, Amanda C. remaining with her parents until her marriage. She received a good education in her native community and taught school very successfully in Lawrence county, Ohio, at the Furnaces. Upon their marriage, Mr. and Mrs. Pistole settled on a farm just north of the present Pistole home, entering land from the government one year later, which has remained the home of the family ever since, William M. having spent his life here. He owned another farm, five and one-half miles northwest, on the east side of the One Hundred and Two river, owning there a good bottom farm. The home farm contained four hundred and fifteen acres. He became one of the well-to-do agriculturists of this township, owning over seven hundred acres in all at the time of his death. He engaged extensively in stock raising and feeding, also bought and shipped livestock in large numbers.

The present commodious home of the Pistole family was built in 1872. He also erected a large and substantial barn, having built his first barn here over fifty years ago. His first house was built of brick. Politically, Mr. Pistole was a Democrat, and he took more than a passing interest in party affairs. He served as county judge for a time in a manner that won the hearty commendation of his constituents and all concerned. He was a member of the Christian church at Pickering. The death of this excellent citizen occurred on June 1, 1892. He had been practically an invalid for a number of years, but bore his afflictions with the patience and fortitude of the Christian gentleman that he was. Mrs. Pistole, a woman admired by a wide circle of friends, is living on the home place. Their family consisted of six children, namely: Henry T. lives on a farm in Union township, on the One Hundred and Two river; Lewis H. died when twenty-four years old, leaving two sons; Mentoria A. married Frank S. Maxon, a farmer living on the old homestead; they have no children; Steven S. is engaged in the grocery busi-

ness at Kansas City; Sarah J. married William N. Boatright, of Lamar, Colorado; Charles O. lives in Denver, Colorado, engaged as a carpenter and builder. Each of these children was left a nice farm by their father and are all very comfortably situated.

Mrs. Pistole is a faithful member of the Christian church. Mr. Pistole enlisted on September 1, 1863, in the Missouri state militia in Company A, Fourth Regiment of Cavalry, and was discharged on the 8th of July, 1865,
