Since the other information you sent me stated that Wilkes County was formed from Surry County in 1777, & Surry County from Rowan County in 1771, O chare revised my search for records relevant & John Sater's marriage & a woman named Sarah.

Family history stated that John Sater moved to Wilkes County at the same time that his sister, a her chusband Benjamin Howard, morred there from Baltimore County, Maryland. Since the family chistory states that they moved from Maryland & Wilkes County, NC, then it must have received

after 1777. Ethis would suggest that John Sater married while still lerving in Maryland; particularly since this daughter Elizabeth was born in 1776.

Perhaps, though, since it is known that John Sater died 16 Aug. 1820, it is probable that he was also buried in Surry County. Would it be possible to explore the Cemetery lists of surry County in an attempt to find where

John Sater is buried, as well as his wife Sarah?

Thank you for your letter postmarked August 7, 2002 regarding John Sater and his daughter Elizabeth.

We did not find a marriage bond/marriage for John to Sarah in Surry County. If they were married in the late 1760s, they may have married in Rowan County. Surry formed from Rowan County in 1771. You stated they first came to Wilkes County from the Baltimore, Maryland area. Wilkes County formed from Surry in 1777. The marriage was not found in Wilkes County.

You stated they later moved to Surry near Hunteville/Huntersville. The area was probably Huntsville which is now in Yadkin County.

Local books were checked for family sketches/histories and military information but we were unable to locate any information.

We have enclosed a copy of the abstract of the will of John Sater found in Surry County. If you want a copy of the will, write the Office of Archives and History, Division of Historical Resources, 4614 Mail Srevice Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-4614.

We did not find a marriage bond/marriage for Elizabeth Sater to George Barker in either Surry or Wilkes Counties.

We are very sorry that we were unable to answer your questions on these individuals and provide more information. We would be happy to have a copy of the information on George Barker's Revolutionary War history for our file and possible publication in our journal if we have your permission. A pedigree chart for John Sater and George Barker would be a great addition to our files also.

Best of luck with your research. We will be happy to put a query in our journal for you and place a surname card in our files. Information is enclosed.


