Mrs. May Henry Hunt Worrell, age 100, passed away on December 23, 2018 following a short period of declining health. May Henry was born in Gaston County, North Carolina on August 24, 1918 to the late Henry Marcus Hunt and Ida Mae Wallace Hunt.
