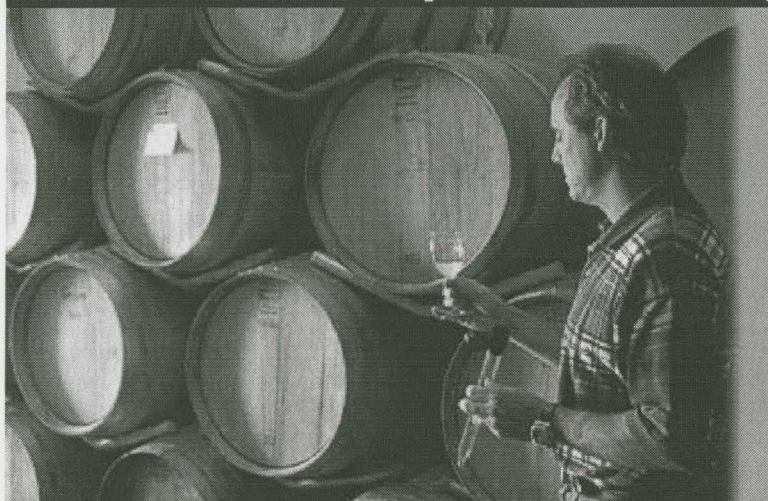



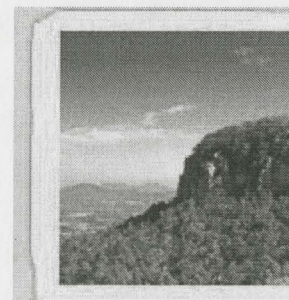

We begin our weekend excursion in the rolling countryside west of Winston-Salem, NC. Our bicycle loop meanders past fields and forests on our way to three of North Carolina's best vineyards, including the Westbend, Hanover Park and RayLen Vineyards. Enjoy meeting the vintners, as you sample the fruits of their labors which have earned them the coveted viticultural appellation for the Yadkin Valley.

Day 2

We will have time after breakfast this morning to explore historic Old Salem, a living, breathing reconstruction of the original Moravian Settlement. Later we will pedal toward historic Bethabara with a stop along the way to marvel at the grandiose Reynolda Estate. You will have a chance to stroll through the beautifully manicured gardens and the visit the museum of American Art housed in the estate. After lunch at Bethabara, our country roads lead us to Pilot Mountain, better known as Mt. Pilot in the Andy Griffiths Show. Tonight's wine tasting event will be at the Wolf's Lair Restaurant at Black Wolf Vineyards.

Day 3

Today's multisport agenda includes a hike to the summit of Pilot Mountain, whose distinctive shape is a landmark visible from many miles away. It provides the perfect setting for a gourmet lunch at the top, a nice reward for making the climb. In the afternoon, we have an optional bike loop that extends from the top of Pilot Mountain down to Shelton Vineyards, perhaps the area's most renowned winery. Much of the afternoon will be spent exploring the impressive grounds while tasting several of their award winning vintages. Tonight we'll enjoy a candlelit catered dinner at our bed & breakfast.

Day 4

This morning we will explore Hanging Rock State Park and its magnificent hiking trails that lead to scenic twelve acre spring-fed lake atop the mountain. Afterwards, the trip adjourns back to Winston-Salem.
