In taking said account, I have charged the
Administrator with receipts to the amount of
Six hundred and twenty seven $327/100$ dollars and
have given him credit for vouchers exhibited
to the amount of Five hundred and thirty six $47/100$
dollars including Five percent commissions on
his receipts and disbursements, which leaves the
said James H. Kendall Admr, indebted to his
Intestates estate in the sum of Ninety $857/100$
dollars, as shown by the foregoing statement.
