have given him credit for vouchers exhibited
to the amount of Five hundred and thirty six 47 $\frac{7}{100}$
dollars including Five per cent commissions on
his receipts and disbursements, which leaves the
said James H. Kendall Admr indebted to his
Intestates estate in the sum of Ninety 85 $\frac{7}{100}$
dollars as shown by the foregoing statement
