That we will maintain private and family devotions religiously educate the children committed to our care and endeavor in purity of heart and meekness of life and good will towards all men to Exemplify and Comend our holy faith to win souls to the savior and hold fast our profession till he shall come and receive us into himself"

A Presbytery consisting of Elders
R. D. Haymore, C. C. Haymore, Julius Ferrill
Pinkney Oliver met at a stand near Westfield
on the first Lords Day in September 1879
and were organized by electing R. D. Haymore
moderator and Bro. J. M. Gessup Clerk and
proceeded to organize the following persons
into an independent Baptist Church, viz.

The following confession of faith and Church
covenant were adopted by the church x

Brother J. C. Simmons and J. L. Barlis were

the Presbytery Eld. Ferrill Leading in prayer,
J. M. Gessup was chosen Clerk, Elder Pinkney
Oliver was unanimously called to serve the
Church as pastor for the next year
