

# Contract

This agreement made  
this the 18th day of  
May 1920 A.D.  
between S. W. Hanko  
Party of the first  
part and F. W. H. J.  
Logan and Charles Bryant  
of the second part.  
Which Hanko party  
of the first part  
agrees to sell to said  
Bryant party of the  
second part all logs  
and saw timber on  
said boundary beginning  
at S. C. Furisham's  
line at a fair of Swan  
Baw below S. W. Hanko  
residence and running

with fence to mouth  
 of S. W. Hawks Spring  
 branch; then west  
 up a hill by a big  
 Chestnut straight  
 to a fence <sup>top of</sup> at Pills  
 then with said fence  
 to a newly cut road;  
 then with said fence  
 road to another fence  
 at edge of fields;  
 then with said  
 fence to a branch  
 coming from the  
~~west~~ place; then  
 with said branch  
 down the branch  
 to S. W. Bryant line;  
 then with S. W. Bryant  
 line to the Spine Pine  
 corner in S. C. Purchon's  
 line, then with

H.C. Purchase's line  
back to beginning at  
bar.

(2) Said Hancock party  
of the first part agrees  
to find to said Bryant  
party of the second  
part 3 three years  
from this date to  
get said work and  
links of boundary.

(3) The said Hancock  
party of the first part  
agrees to find said  
Bryant party of the  
second part a road  
on top of ridge  
through a thicket  
to improve road.

(4) Said Hancock party  
of the first part except  
all acid wood an
