Joseph A. Pell Jr., longtime aide to Gov. Hunt, dies here at age 81

■ Surry Democrat, businessman wanted to make a difference

Joseph A. Pell Jr. wanted people to miss him when he died.

"What I want is to leave enough friends behind that I've helped in life that, when I'm gone, they are going to miss me. And in order to be missed, you have to accomplish a lot of things," he said in 1990.

Pell, who died Sunday at 81, was Gov. Jim Hunt's chief of staff for eight years.

He had also been the chairman of the Surry County Board of Education for 30 years and a tobacco businessman for most of his life.

"He was a very caring, loving man," said his daughter, Linda Sigmon.

Pell once said that a person needs ambition, humility, loyalty and the ability to listen to succeed. "To be successful, you don't ever want to be satisfied with your present position in life," he said.

"A lot of people go through life, and you read their obituary in the newspaper. It might read in there that they were 100 years old. But I'm not interested in their age. I don't care if they were 60 or 100. What I want to know is what they did with their lives. What they accomplished in that 60 or 100 years."

Pell was a heavy hitter in the Democratic Party. He was a chairman of the Surry County Democratic Party and a close confidant of Hunt's. He spent years campaigning for Hunt and helping him in the governor's office.

Hunt plans to speak at Pell's funeral Wednesday at the First United Methodist Church in Pilot Mountain, the church Pell attended for years.

Pell became Hunt's chief of staff in 1977. He told Hunt that he didn't want to be paid. Hunt insisted, and Pell eventually agreed to take enough money to cover his living expenses. He never accepted a salary.

"Joe was a dear friend, mentor, trusted adviser and a great North Carolinian," Hunt said. "He fought tirelessly for the things he believed in, and he loved this state. His strong business sense and his commitment to education taught me a great deal about how to be a better leader."

Pell's daughter, Sigmon, said, "His whole, entire life he worked for his state and his community. He was out

shaking hands with the farmers from an early age. He always loved politics."

Pell was born in Pilot Mountain and was a fixture in that community for years.

He met his wife, Mary Tuttle Awarner, when she came to Pilot Mountain to work as a teacher. A friend suggested they go meet the new "good-looking school-teachers," Sigmon said. Pell and his friend both fell in love, and each married a new teacher.

In the early 1960s, Pell was the president of the N.C. School Board Association and the president of the Southeastern School Board Association.

Pell was the president of Growers Warehouse Co. and the president of Growers Tobacco Storage Corp., both in Winston-Salem. He was also the director of a Kinston bank and the chairman of Pellcare Corp., which runs the nursing home in Winston-Salem where Pell died.

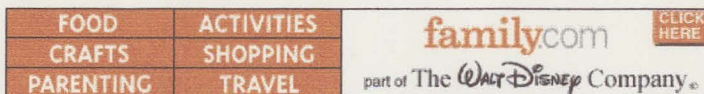
"He always had time to listen to what you thought, and then he would wisely direct you," Sigmon said. "I think that his purpose in life was, first of all, his family, but he loved this state of North Carolina, he really did."

PILOT MOUNTAIN — Mr. Joseph Andrew Pell, Jr., age 81, of 133 Mountain View Road, Pilot Mountain, N.C., died Sunday morning, August 3, 1997, at Pellcare, Inc. of Winston-Salem, N.C. after an extended illness. Mr. Pell was born in Surry County, October 19, 1915, to Joseph Andrew and Molly Hiatt Pell. Mr. Pell was educated in the Surry County Public Schools and was a graduate of Duke University where he majored in Business Administration. He was Chairman of the Board of Trustees of First United Methodist Church in Pilot Mountain where he was an active member. Mr. Pell was Chairman for 30 years of the Surry County Board of Education. He was President of the North Carolina State School Board Association from 1960-1962 and was President of the Southeastern School Board Association from 1962-1964. Mr. Pell was a Director of First Financial Bank in Kinston, N.C. Mr. Pell was Chairman of the Board of Pellcare Corporation, Winston-Salem, N.C. and Hickory, N.C. He was President of Growers Warehouse Company and was President of Growers Tobacco Storage Corporation, Winston-Salem, N.C. Mr. Pell was a tobacco warehouse owner and operator in Fairmont, N.C. for 33 years, Winston-Salem, N.C. for 33 years, and Shelbyville, Kentucky for 10 years. He was President of the Bright Belt Tobacco Warehouse Association for two years. Mr. Pell was very active in the Democratic Party from 1943 to present. He served as Chairman of the Surry County Democratic Party from 1960-1968. Mr. Pell was selected Fifth District Democrat of the Year in 1977. He was Senior Assistant and Chief of Staff to Governor

James B. Hunt, Jr., from 1977-1984. Mr. Pell's hobbies included golf and bridge. Mr. Pell will be missed by all who knew and loved him. Surviving are his wife, Mary Tuttle Atwater Pell, of the home. Mrs. Pell is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Luther E. Atwater, Burlington, N.C. One daughter and son-in-law, Linda P. and Bob Sigmon, Savannah, Georgia; one son, and daughter-in-law, Joseph Andrew Pell, III and wife, Crystal, Pilot Mountain, N.C.; one granddaughter; four grandsons; one great granddaughter; one great grandson. one sister, Evelyn Burnside, Wilson, N.C.; two brothers, Phillip H. Pell, and Allan Pell, both of Las Vegas, Nevada. Funeral services will be conducted Wednesday morning, August 6, 1997, at 11 a.m. at First United Methodist Church in Pilot Mountain, N.C. by the Rev. Sidney Lanier, Rev. Jim Boles, and special speaker, Governor, James B. Hunt, Jr. Burial will be in the Pilot Mountain City Cemetery. Mr. Pell is at the Cox-Needham Funeral Home and Chapel in Pilot Mountain, N.C. and will be taken to the Church on Tuesday evening at 5:30 p.m. where he will remain until the hour of the service. Thank you for your letter dated March 22, 2002 regarding your Anderson ancestors that are buried in the Pell Cemetery. You wanted to know the location of the Pell Cemetery in Stokes County, NC.

The directions we have of the Pell Cemetery in Stokes are as follows:

Off Highway 89, turn on Asbury Road, go about three miles on Asbury Road and turn right on Jessup Road. Immediately, turn right on Frans and go one mile to Christian Road. Just past Christian Road, go to the 1st brick house on the right and the cemetery is located behind this house. Kay Dearmin Cook lives in the house.

We understand there are no names on the stones in this cemetery. There are just field rocks in the cemetery.

At the Stokes/Rockingham Genealogical Swap Meeting on this past Saturday at Mount Olive Baptist Church we were discussing this cemetery, getting directions, etc. There was another man there looking for the same cemetery that you had written to that lives in Pinnacle (we did not get his name). Anyhow, I told him I would write you and give you the directions. We hope you find the cemetery from these directions.

As far as we know Stuart, Virginia was never a part of Surry County. Stokes was formed from Surry County in 1789. We checked some of our early records and did not find your Anderson ancestor you listed in Surry County.

Enclosed also is a copy of a map (three parts) that shows some cemeteries. We are not sure if the Pell Cemetery is one of these cemeteries or not. They are probably church cemeteries.

Good luck with finding the cemetery. If we can help further, please let us know.
